



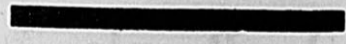
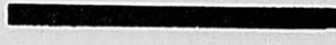

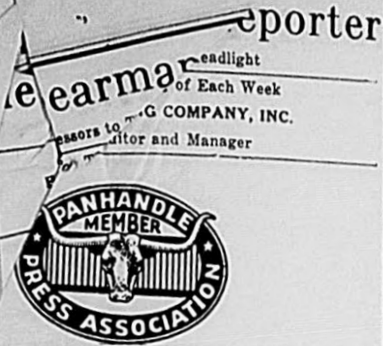

Jesus Meeting My Needs.
 The Gospel of Luke is the longest book in the New Testament being slightly longer than the Acts. And Luke is the only Evangelist who records all of the seven greatest events in the life of Jesus: His birth baptism temptation transfiguration death resurrection and ascension. About half of Luke's entire Gospel is not given by other Evangelists.
 The key-note of the Gospel is found in Luke "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost. Luke's special purpose seems to have been to prove to his own countrymen the trees that Jesus is the Savior not only of Jews but of the whole world. All through his Gospel we notice how he gives prominence of Jesus' mission to the poor and the outcast." Luke's Gospel gives us the account of the infancy and youth of Jesus. Here alone are we given the accounts of the forerunner's birth the presentation in the Temple the adoration of the shepherds and the visit to the Temple of the boy at the age of twelve. To Luke also are we indebted for many of our greatest parables not given by the other writers.
