are going to overthrow the Government of the United States by force？Who are they？The Communist Party is one af the recognized political parties of this coun－ try，having an official place on the ballot in practically every State．At the Presidential election of 1932， when all the circumstances were calculated to encour－ age every element which wanted a change in the Gov－ errment，the Communist candidate for the Presidency，
William Z．Foster，received fewer than 90,000 votes． William Z．Foster，received fewer than 90,000 votes．
As compared with the 38 million votes that were cast， that does not look like much of a menace．Norman Thomas，the Socialist candidate，polled nearly ten times as many votes．
Our observation of Communists is that they take
it out in talk，which is their indisputable right．And if they can muster enough votes to control the Gover－ nment of the United States，that is also their indispu－ table right，the same right that Democrats and Repub－ licans have．It seems to us rather silly to try to prevent anybody from talking，in a nation dedicated to the

of ssed and aids，rather than hampers，their cause．
We have no fear that the people of the United State will turn Communist，at least in our time．But a lot of people get a great deal of satisfaction，in the nature
