As a relief for what little unemployment that may exist in Spearman at the present time, the city commissioners could do nothing better than stage a genuine high-lass street improvement campaign. Many streets of the town are tough, awful rough. These could be dragged down smooth, and better still: There are several gravel pits near Spearman. Some of the principal streets should be graveled. This will not only nake a god, substantial road bed, but it also prevents so much mud being brought in to the paved sections on the wheels of vehicles. Practically every street in the city should be given some attention, the principal streets should be graveled and the highways leading into town should be traveled for a mile or more. This will furnish employment for many and will result in a permanent, substantial improvement of which the entire town and community will be proud.

The legislative mill of Texas, with headquarters in Austin, is now grinding. What the grist will be, the forces, under the head miller, Covernor Sterling and the designated 120 days will determine. There already is talk of a state-wide bond issue for road improvement purposes. What this section of the state is interested in principally is: Road building, a tax on natural gas, an agricultural experiment station, which will give particular attention to wheat-raising and feeding of livestock, ami an honest administration of affairs all along the line. The north plains country is not interested in "relief legislation." What the north plains wants is a square leal. Given that, it will get along fairly well, thank you.

In order to create jobs for the unemployed the city of Amarillo and Potter county will put the machinery in the sheds and go back to the shovel and the hoe; the pick, the spade and the horse-drawn plow. This, no doubt, will increase the number of "jobs" and the work will be just as well done. On the other hand, should this method be adopted throughout the state and nation, the big manufacturing plants would no longer make tractors, ditching machines of other big, labor-saving machinery, so thousands of factory hands would be thrown out of employment. Modern machinery does not throw men out of employment it usually causes a business to grow and expand to such an extent that additional help is required.

PROTECTION FOR FARMERS

A suggestion from John E. Hill of Amarillo to Forbes Magazine recently that the time has come for the farmers to have the same trade protection as industrialists have received, has brought numerous experssions of approval from financial leaders.






