Interchurch World Movemen Natural Growth of Tendency to Eliminato Wasto.
AVOIDS USELESS COMPETITION Roligious Financioring Movement man and Mililion - Rosult. The Interchurch World Movemen or North America is an attempt by orangellical denominations of the Unit ed states and Canada to co-ordinate the resources in men, money and Historicaly it is the lozical out srowth of a tendency of the national boards in each denomination to form working alliances among themselves,
in which each board shall preserve its In which each board shall preserve its
Identity and control its own personnel and treasury.
In former times, the home mission eociety, the foreegn mission society,
the church extension society the church extension society and the
various philanthropic and eleemosy. various philanthropic and eleemoson-
nary agencles of any denomination conaucted their affairs independently of
one another. Eath eurvered its one another. Each surveyed its own
restricted territory, prepared a budget resiricted territory, prepared a budget
of money and workers for lits own purposes and made. its own appeal to its constituency for support.
This could only mean that the agencles ware more or less in comwere waste and duplication of work and money, and that among them all
some work was neglected and some denominational resources were entire. epecialized tratning, the leaders of each agency regarded themselves as
pecullarly fitted for thelr tasks, and peculiarly fitted for their casks, and
jealously regarded attempts at outside
interl interference.

Decide on Experiment.
After decades of such haphazard methods, the leaders of one denomina
ton decided on an experiment. They
thought it thought it would be possible for the
ageneles to get together for a com agencees to get together for a com.
mon study of all the opportunitles and
resources of their brotherhood to make out a unified budget of men and money, and to conduct a concerted appeal for funds. It was made clear
that each constituent board should that each constituent boary
preserve complete autonomy.
When the board representatives
met they found it possible to ellim! nate a great amount of organization
oxpenses. They ultimately worked out a budget and plan of campalgn that was satisfactory to all. This resulted
in the famous "Mon and Millions Which brought in what was then con sldered the staggering sum of $\$ 6,300$. 000 for a tive-year program. The success of this enterprise revo lutionized the whole church financiering. The other great church nnanciering. The other srethed
denominations immediately adopted the plan. The denominational associations have come to be known as "for
Fard movements," and some thirty of them are in existence today. Each one has clarified all the information in reIation to enterprise within the denom
