Saturday is election day!

City Elections for the City of Spearman will be held Saturday, April 5, 1986. A Mayor and Two Alderman will be elected for the City of Spearman. All three candidates are unopposed. C. Ralph Blodgett is running for Mayor and Jim Nicholson and Ed Garner are running for Alderman. In the School Board race five candidates are running for three positions on the Board. The ballot will list the following; Tom Latta, Robert Queener, Jr., Charles

Shieldknight, Dennis Nelson, and Craig D. Schumann. The Election will be held at the High School in Spearman with the voting boxes opening at 7:00 a.m. and closing at 7:00 p.m. Both City and School Elections will be held at the School. In a talk with Jim Murray at the City Hall, we learned that two Absentee Ballots had been cast in the City Election and we were unable to find the total of absentee

in the School Board elections because of the Easter Holiday.
