## How much of Social Security

 tax dollar earmarked for paying monthly retirement, disability, and survivors benefits is actually used for this purpose? And howmuch is used to run the program?

## In an op

In an opinion poll a few years ed that less than half of each tax dollar went for benefits. And only about one person in 20 said at least 80 percent of the tax money was paid in benefits. In truth, about 98.6 cents from each tax dollar paid in 1983 went directly to make payments to benefits. And only 1.4 cents went for administrative expen-
ses.
It's true that the Social Se curity Administration's administrative costo-in dollars and conts have gone up over the years as its programs have costs in relation to tex those has steadily decreased. For example, it took 1.6 cents from each tax dollar to run the program 5 years ago; and about 2.0 cents a decade ago.

Administrative expenses include such items as salaries, rental of property and equipment, building operating expenses, and supplies. They also

Farm income $57 \%$ below parity

July 26, 1984. The District Director for the Texas Farmers Union has announced the June
parity index, from figures released by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The farm 'cost-of-living' figure is
down to a below-satisfactory $57 \%$ says Burton Schubert of Hansford Countr. The farm ecomony is defintely lagging behind the rest
the American economy; this parity index has gone down as opposed to rising over the past
few months. Add that to the few months. Add that to the
increasing interest rates across increasing interest rates across
the country, and the farmers everywhere are hurting," claims Schubert.
The parity
The parity index is the relationship between the price received
for a commodity, and its pur- chasing power in today's marke
place, versus the same trans action performed during the years between 1909 and 1914. It is a yardstick that farmers use to
measure the relative strength of measure the relative strength of
farm income today, as compared to the 'Golden Age' of agriculture in the early 1900's. To illustrate, the price received
for a pound of cotton is .72 (cents) for a pound of cotton is. 72 (cents)
as opposed to the parity price of \$1.27. This means that while the
cost cost of living and raw materials has gone up drastically in the past
seventy years, that pound of seventy years, that pound of
cotton will only purchase a little more than half of what it brought at the following figures were
