designed. Hanfling said, designed. Hanfling said, how
ever, that ell toys should be checked for suitability sinoe a chicked for suitabill skill development may very from others of the same age.

Missile-type toys such as bow and arrow sets, BB guns, darts
and non-powder firearms are a major cause of injuries. Perents should determine when a child is old enough to play with this kind of toy rather than relying on the
manufacturers recommendation, mannuacturen
Hanfling said.
These can be very powerful weapons and should never be given to unsupervised children," e said. Parents should treat real firearms."
He said parents may want to purchase protective goggles for children playing with missile-type toys or for older children using
chemistry sets. The goggles will crotect the eyes, which are the most vulnerable area to injury. Once the holidays are over, Hanfling advises that all toys are
