# Hansford woman is own 'handiman'

Working concrete, refinishing and reupholstery of furniture, woodwork and the building of a carport and workshop is no small chore for anyone -- but, when you're 83-year old widow and these events took place in your recent past, a person tends to look upon those accomplishments with a pardonable amount of pride.

That's the case for Hazel Jackson of Spearman, a Hansford woman who has had to make it on her own since she lost her husband in 1950.

The journey has been an up hill and down the valley type journey, but its one the tenacious Mrs. Jackson has made in her own determined and undaunting fashion.

Today, hampered by arthritis the venerable Hansford woman looks back on quite a few accomplishments -- not all of them from the last few years, either.

Hazel came to Hansford county at the age of 14, in charge of a group of her cousins whom she shepherded from Kansas City, Mo., to her aunt and uncle who were already living in the Texas Panhandle.

Her parents followed her shortly, coming about the time old Hansford was breaking up and moving from the Palo Duro draw into both Spearman and Gruver.

Spearman became her home and she finished her education and later married. Then, during the great depression, she and her two

daughters moved to Greenleaf, Kan. to be with her mother who had moved up there.

She came back to Hansford county in 1943, then she and her husband moved to Arkansas where they lived until his death in 1950.

From there she moved to Denver to live with her oldest daughter, an arrangement which lasted for about two years before she decided to head back to the place which had become home for her -- the Texas Panhandle.

She found work in Perryton where she sewed in a dress shop. Shortly thereafter, she moved to Amarillo to attend business school and, upon graduation, took a pair of jobs as a bookkeeper for a good supply company and a motel.

She held down those positions for over a decade before moving to Dumas to take up secretarial and bookkeeping chores for a hotel there. Later she was named manager of the hotel, a position she held for two years before the desire to return to her adopted "home" resurfaced.

"Spearman has always been home to me," she remembers with a smile. "No matter where I was, when I talked about home, I was talking about Hansford county."

Once back in the county, she served as bookkeeper-receptionist for Dr. Damon Gregg, a position she held until her retirement in early 1971.

## THE HANSFORD REPORT

In Haiti this past weekend, 34 people died in election day violence. It was supposed to be the first free election in that small country's history.

Poverty is so extreme there that the mortality rate among children is near the 50 percent mark. More than half of the country's population is illiterate.

But they all wanted to vote. There were 26 people running for president. There is some question whether those voting were capable of knowing which of the 26 candidates would be the best choice.

Their choice was to vote -- right or wrong. Even after the violence erupted, the lines formed again. They wanted to vote.

And they kept trying until the military regime who currently run Haiti called the elections off.

People were dying, literally, for that opportunity. And they still lined up to vote. Uneducated, poor, starving . . . they lined up to vote because they knew it was important. That vote was their first step toward freedom as a people.

It almost makes one physically ill to hear the excuses people make in America for not exercising that freedom.

If the poor, illiterate people of Haiti recognize its importance, how can we as individuals, or as a nation, ignore that same freedom?

We can't. Not without appearing lazy, apathetic, or both. Next time it comes time to vote, remember the blood flowing in the streets of Haiti. It's that important.

On a lighter note, the short skirt is finding its way back into the fashion scene. It's very popular on both coasts right now which means it should reach middle America sometime within the next two to three years.

For us inveterate leg fanciers, it's a fashion that has been too long out of vogue. For the ladies, it's probably something which is alright during the summer, but highly questionable during the winter.

Being your standard, upright, red-blooded American male -- I enjoy short skirts. That is as long as its not my wife, daughter, sisters or nieces wearing them.

Call that a double standard if you wish. I call it protecting my own. I'm so old fashioned, I don't even allow short shorts during the summer.

But that doesn't keep me from enjoying the view offered by those who do.

This will probably jinx the entire situation, but it's one which has had employers and school officials

alike hopping for the past six weeks or so.

We alluded to it a couple of editions earlier when we talked about running short-handed due to the rash of illnesses lately.

This week -- thank God -- we have a full crew for the first time in that six-week period.

The classes at school are beginning to fill back up and mothers and fathers across the county are beginning to breathe easier as their

## Services set today for Hansford civic leader

An active Hansford county civic and social leader, John C. Venneman, died Tuesday in Amarillo following a short illness.

Funeral Mass of the Resurrection will be held today (Thursday) at 11 a.m. in the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Spearman for the Hansford county pioneer.

Rosary was recited Wednesday in the Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Funeral Mass for Mr. Venneman will be officiated by the Rev. Patrick Walsh, S.A., pastor, Monsignor Joseph Tash of St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church in Amarillo, and Monsignor Francis Smyer of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Amarillo.

Burial will be in Hansford Cemetery by Boxwell Brothers Funeral Home. Mr. Venneman was 75 years old and a lifetime resident of Hansford county.

Born in Chillicothe, he was a retired farmer and rancher in Hansford county. He was married to Fannie Sparks in 1941 at Borger.

Mr. Venneman was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and St. Mary's Catholic Church in Amarillo.

He was a past member of the Hansford Soil Conservation District board of directors, a former Hansford County commissioner, a former FFA Farmer of the Year and a former SCS Farmer of the Year.

Mr. Venneman was active in all phases of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, including the Parish Council.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Joe T.; two daughters, Hattie Davis of Hooker, Ok., and Mary Ed Venneman of the home;

A sister, Clementine Renner of Spearman; and six grandchildren.

The family requests memorials be to St. Anthony's Hospice in Amarillo, to the Station Master's House Museum or a favorite charity.

Gifts to the Manor Fund are tax deductible and fill a need which is great right now -- and are gifts that keep on giving throughout the upcoming year as well.

The 1987 Manor Empty Stocking Fund is just now getting underway. In the past the fund has totaled near \$1,500, but the needs this year are greater than before and the opportunities to make a lasting difference have never been more apparent.

Then, after a 6-year layoff, I returned to the newspaper world. And, it's surprising what will set people off.

With all the world-shattering happenings going on constantly in the world, do we worry about the Persian Gulf problems? Oh, no.

Do we worry about the approaching Russian summit meeting in our nation's capital? Oh, no.

But, run a story about a man getting a traffic ticket and you've stirred up a hornet's nest. The story was innocuous, one of those just the facts type stories.

I received a call from one city official who was concerned they would receive a flurry of calls for because the "whole" story wasn't printed. And, then, I got to hear the "whole" story.

I also received a call from an indignant woman who didn't bother to identify herself wanting to know why I was "picking" on this one individual.

She claimed that if I knew the "whole" story behind the incident that I wouldn't have been so callous in writing the 4-paragraph story.

I have to chuckle just a bit, because I believe there are two versions of the "whole" story running around.

Fortunately, I'm not the judge. I'm just the lowly publisher of a country newspaper who looks forward each day to find out what headline or sentence will offend the next reader.

Despite some beliefs, it's not something I go around looking for or attempting to do on purpose.

Having been married for sometime, I have found that even after nearly 18 years, I don't really know what will set my wife off next. And she has the same problem.

Naturally, in any paper, no matter what its size or scope, editors do their best to have something that will pique the minds of its readers -- and that can be pro or con.

And, there are those who just aren't happy unless they have the opportunity to right some wrong or correct some injustice -- whether that wrong or that injustice actually exists is beside the point.

I'm glad that, as a semi-public forum, we are able to give them that opportunity.

And, with that statement, she gives vent to the lament of every woman around.

Basically, she gave up bookkeeping and continued to work at sewing -- a duty she later discovered contributed to an acute hearing loss.

"I was already wearing a hearing aid at the time," she states. "But I was allergic to the fabric I was working with and eventually lost almost all my hearing."

In and out of Hansford county most of her adult life, Hazel's experiences helped forge a determined woman. And it's that determination which has carried her since moving back to Spearman in 1965.

"We lost our home during the depression and so my home now is very important to me," she declares.

It's that love of home, coupled with depression experience, which led the tenacious Hansford lady into the woodworking and furniture refinishing areas.

"I knew if I wanted it, I'd have to do it myself," she laughs. "After losing one home, I wanted one I could call my own."

And her own it is, too. A good deal of the finish work inside her home in Spearman was done by her own hands.

A curio cabinet was her first work, she built a carpenter on her house, has completely refinished and reupholstered her living room furniture plus myriad other works.

Some of those works include a pedestal dining room table, the headboard of her bed and special 4-cabinet chest in her bedroom.

"Once you've made up your mind you can do something, you can," she states matter-of-factly. "I wouldn't have the things I have now if I hadn't done it myself."

She has received a good deal of help from her son-in-law who lives in Spearman, but for the most part the work has been done by her own hands.

Despite surgery this past February to relieve pressure on nerves along her spinal column created by arthritic bone spurs, Hazel still gets around with an alacrity which belies her years.

Active in the First Christian Church in Spearman, she also finds time to make occasional events at the Golden Sprad Senior citizen's Center -- that is, when she's not working in her yard.

Her home is immaculate and she has managed to add some interesting and unique touches to it with woodworking handiwork -- such as turning an abandoned air cooler vent into a shadow box.

She's even managed to build a 12x12 workshop out back so she could move her woodworking out of her kitchen.

What would she do if she had it to do all over again . . . "I'd make my house bigger," she exclaims. "I just don't have enough storage space."

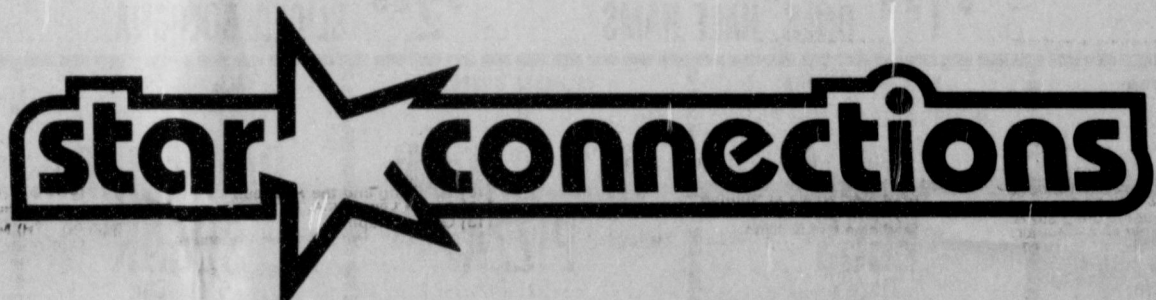

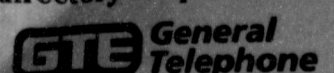
