## RETURN OF ROADS PLEASES FARMERS

Urge Policy to Insure Best Serv ice at Lowest Cost Consistent With Fair Returns.

OPPOSE NATIONALIZATION Representative Agricultural Organizations and Rural Prese state Farm-, Want Pivato Oparation -
Private ownershlp of the rallioade inder a policy of government regulabervice at the lowest cost consistent with falr returns on money invested in them is favored by representative
farmer organizations throughout the armer organizations throughout the
country. This pollcy also is supported senerally by agricultural newspapers which state emphatically that the farmers are opposed not only to government ownership of rallroads,
also to all nationalization plans, also to all nationalization plans.
In a letter to the members of the
United States Senate Washington representative of the Na tlonal Grange, which is sald to be the largest organization of its kind in the worid, representing more than 1,000,
000 farm owners in the United States, states that the agricultural interests of the country approve of private owner ship of the rallioads and further de clares that persons purporting to speak for the farmers in support of gover
ment ownershlp are nelther farmers nor representatives of any considerable number of farmers.

Favor Private Operation. quoting the ofilial action of his or canization, "approves of the general
principles of rallioad legislation now pending in Congress to return the rallroads to thelr owners, to bring abou the reorganization of the ralliroad com pqhles fito strong systems with capl-
tallzation based on tallzation based on actual value, and
