| BRIGHTON, England - A former British prime minister predicted Friday that Communist China will remain an enemy of the Soviet Union permanently. <br> Sir Alec Douglas-Home told the annual convention of the opposition Conservative party he once headed that the consequence of the rasis risilan-Chinetw of interest between the Soviet and Europe." <br> But he declared that the Soviet Union has abandoned neither its revolutionary aims nor its old-style imperialist dreams. <br> At the windup of a foreign affairs debate, Sir Alec said all of the crucially important Middle East "is wide open to a Russian presence and Russian influence", and for this he partly blamed President Gamal Abdel Nasser of Egypt. <br> "The object of the Egyptians and the Soviet Union the Middle East, is to change the balance of world power," he sald. |
