Raiders End Year With Loyola Win

NEW ORLEANS, Dec. 5—The Red Raiders of Texas Tech took advantage of the break to close their season with a 13 to 0 victory over Loyola here Saturday night.

The Techs converted a Loyola fumble into a touchdown in the second period, then scored again after blocking a Wolfpack punt in the dying seconds of the game.

Both teams threatened to score constantly, but except for the two Tech markers, staunch defensive play near the double stripes checked all drives.

Charley Calhoun scored first, carrying over from the four after Tech took the ball on the Loyola ten. Flusche's point try was blocked.

After that it was almost even until the last three minutes of the game. Then Bill Brown broke through to block a Loyola punt and Durwood Herring recovered for Tech on the Loyola 11-yard line.

The game was the top attraction of a Loyola homecoming celebration some 3500 fans attending.
