, No doubt as many students face final
examinations for this semester with the
odds against passing staring them in the
face, this question flashes through the mind.
To this inquiry many answers have been
proposed. Hoping that the bewildered stu-
dent may get hold of the cause and correct
it by concentrated hours of studying the
Toreador lists these as chief among the
causes:
Lack of information, lack of maturity,
lack of a desire to learn, lack of adjust-
ment to coilege life, lack of industry, lack
of ability to do the work, lack of physsical
strength, lack of emotional stability, lack
of effective study habits, lack of power of
concentration, lack of ability to analyze,
lack of proper attitudes, lack of proper re-
actions to learning exercises, lack of at-
tractive personality traits, lack of zeal and
enthusiasm for learning, lack of definite
goals, ack of heagh standards or scholar-
ship, excessive participation in social acti-
vities, excessive load of labor or athletic
activities, etce
These causes of failure are usually and
rightly laid at the feet of the students
themselves. There is probably a good in-
tellectual banquet spread before many of
those who fail but they never taste the de-
lights thereof. But what of other causes of
failure?
THERE is another side of the picture deal-
ithe
ing with college failures. That side has to their instructors and are not fed. Or,
they ask for bread and are given a stone.
The perfect college does not exist; neither
has the perfect lesson been taught. Con-
sider some of the common faults of colleges
and college teaching that contribute either and college teaching that contribute either
directly or indirectly to the list of failures
each semester:
Poor methods of presenting subject
matter, a dogmatic assumption that the matter, a dogmatic assumption that the
courses offered are quite satisfactory, un-
satisfactory integration of curriculum consatisfactory integration of curriculum con-
tent, policy of molding all students into the
same groove, swamping young students
with heavy with heavy and at times uneducative as
signments, false idea that the failing of stu
dents upholds standards-the attitude "eliminating" rather than "saving," un-
fair and inaccurate methods of marking competition among the departments in the
college, tendency to belittle the intelligence of parents and students, tendency to under
rate the work of the secondary schools
tendency of instructors to be arbitrary and tendency of instructors to be arbitrary and
dogmatic, failure to relate teaching to real-
life situations, unwillingness to give largely
 manner as to make thit student succeed?
