## President Nixon re-elected in sweeping landslide win

President Nixion swept to towering reelection Tuesday night, $\begin{aligned} & \text { burying } \\ & \text { Democratic challenger George }\end{aligned}$ McGovern in one of history's greatest landslides.
But wid
But widespread ticket-spliting appeared to be blunting the impact of
Nixon's triumph on the fortunes of some other Republican candidates. Sen. George McGovern conceded defeat Tuesday night and pledeged full
support to landslide victor President support to landslide victor President
Nixon. McGovern told supports at what he
hoped would be a victory celebration that he had sent Nixon a telegram promising he had sent Nixon a teelegram promising
full backing of his efforts to bring peace abroad and justice at home.
"If we pushed the day "If we pushed the day of peace just one day closer, then every minute and every
hour and every bone-crushing effort in hour and every bone-crusting eafirif tin
this campaign was worth the sacrifice," McGovern said.

per cent of the presidential vote. That was in Kansas.
