Although Purely Spanish, La Goya Is Cosmopolitan

Though purely Spanish in every sense of the word, we believe Carola Goya might be called a cosmopolitan dancer. Not only is her art appreciated in her native Spain, but she is hailed as one of the world's greatest dancers in London, New York and cities throughout South America.

La Goya began as a star, in her early teens. From the very first she alone, except for musical interludes, held audiences during entire performances. But despite her skyrocket journey to success, she constantly improves. For the last several seasons she has made a coast to coast tour of the United States, and each time well known critics acclaim her as better than ever before.

An important feature of La Goya's program is her skillful handling of her castenets, and, despite our rapid progress in manufacturing, a Spanish dancer finds it difficult to keep a sufficient supply of these articles in the United States. The reason—none of the right quality and timber are made in this country, and the best are none too plentiful in Spain.

However, the senorita recently received three pairs of the best from a friend in war-torn Spain. Their arrival was delayed a month because of war conditions. The friend wrote that these were the only ones he could find "worthy of being used by an artist of Senorita Goya's standing."

Literally translated, castenets means chestnut. The Moorish percussion instruments were so named, because a pair of them resemble a chestnut when bisected laterally. However, the best castenets are made from the pomegranate rather than the chestnut tree. The colloquial name for castenets in Spain is "pallios", which means toothpicks.
