# New Document To Be Voted **On At Called Convocation:**

**Two Student Courts Created** 

# Council Members Believe That Present Constitution No Longer Fulfills Needs Of Texas Tech Students; Several Changes Provided For

Charges Provided For Believing that the present constitution of Texas Tech no longer fulfills the needs of the student body, that the present one is out of date for this fast grow-ing school, and that a new one is needed, the Student council has submitted to the students of Texas Tech a new constitution. The entire document is printed in the issue of The Toreador. Garland Smith is chairman of the Constitutional formmittee which drew up the proposed document. Mem-tare to call a special convocation within the next few weeks at which time the students will either approve or reject the new document. If approved, it will take the place of the cld one immediately. Included among the changes from the old constitu-ment, creation of two student courts, a provision for a sys-tem of preferential voting, and a change in the publica-tion board. No change is made in the representation in the student Council.
