#### IT MAY BE FATAL!

This is the season of the year when no one is immune from two diseases—"spring fever" and "fishitis". Care should be taken to check either in its incipiency. The two diseases are similar; in fact, "spring fever" seems to be a symptom of "fishitis." ## IS THE MASTER'S THESIS NECESSARY?

IS THE MASTER'S THESIS NECESSARY?

The advisability of eliminating the Master's thesis is a question of much interest. The primary purpose of the thesis is to give the candidate a chance to seek out and organize new material. It is supposed to constitute a real contribution to knowledge, but such is not always the case for varying causes. In some schools the facilities for research are not of the best; often it is necessary to borrow material from other institutions, and delays, hindrances, and other complications arise.

But most objectionable of all is the fact that often the candidate is abolutely unprepared for such an extensive project. He has had no training in original research nor in writing up long papers. He centers all his practical experience on a single exhaustive study, putting both himself and his supervisor at a disadvantage. Advanced research on such a large scale only uses up time and thought that could be more profitably devoted to specialized courses and to outside reading.

Many leading colleges maintain that writing or not writing a thesis should be a matter of individual choice, depending on the student's plans for the future. At Harvard, for instance, comparatively short essays are written for several different courses. This practice in writing prepares the candidate for truly valuable work on his doctorate later on. Likewise, at Yale original results are not demanded, only essays, and reports. Minor pieces of research, term reports, and comparative studies enlarge the student's field of knowledge more efficiently and completely than a poorly executed research project.

Work on a Master's degree should not be a year-long nightmare to the candidate, to be forgotten as soon as completed; it should be an opportunity to round out his knowledge and ability in such a way as to prepare him either for a career or for further research.

If leading universities and colleges, with well equip—

ped facilities for research and original investigation, have seen fit to discontinue the formal thesis, the Toreador believes that the practice might well be followed here at


