Next year the voters of the State of Texas will elect a new Governor, a Lieutenant-Governor, 15 Senators, and 150 Representatives. Will you have a part in electing those men? Among the candidates will be found the names of several Tech graduates.

Presumably one of the most important things that you learned at Tech was the value of good citizenship and an abiding faith in the principles of Democracy. It was radiated on you from every side. Texas Tech did its part for you. Now its your turn. The men who fill those positions next year will hold the future of Texas Tech in their hands. Even though you are not interested in Texas Tech you should be among those electors who choose our governmental officials for the next two years.

But the law requires that one of the qualifications for voting is paying the poll tax. It costs only \$1.75. If you were among those who did not get to vote on the Constitutional Amendments last summer learn a lesson from experience for several others just as important will be presented to the people next year in addition to the officers that are to be elected.

The fight for the preservation of an intact Texas Technological College has only begun. Last year's battle in the Legislature was only the opening skirmish. It will be a battle to the finish this time. Texas Tech will need your help. The State of Texas needs college trained men and women as voters. So pay your poll taxes. There is a tax collector at 257 county seats in Texas who will take your money and issue you a receipt now. Will you be ready to cast your ballot?
