Woolworth's. Woolworth's. lege students who staged the first lunch counter sit-in Feb. 1, 1960. "All I wanted was a Coke and a doughnut." "If someone had come up behind

have fallen off the stool," said another protester, David Richmond. When McCain and his three college

ago, their sit-in touched off similar protests across the South. During their sit-in, which began about 4 p.m., a policeman stood near them and slapped his billyclub in the palm of his hand a few times, but they

Costa Rica's celebration of democracy century-strong


Three months ago Costa Rica celebrated its 100th anniversary of democracy - a rare privilege in
Latin America. This Monday, Costa Ricans return to the ballots to democratically elect a new president to serve a four-year period.
Even thuugh there are morior than 10 political par-
ties in Costa Rica, the estimates are that about 86 ties in Costa Rica, the estimates are that about 86 percent of the voters are divided into 43 percent for Rafael Angel Calderon Jr. of the Christian Unit
Party (PUSC) and 43 percent for Dr Carlos Manuel Castillo of the National Liberation Party (PLN) and that a remaining 12 percent are undecided and 2 percent are for the remaining organizations, including the Communist Party. Angel Calderon Jr, a 40-year-old Reor Rafae Angel Calderon Jr ., a 40 -year-old Republican
lawyer, whose most remarkable background is the fact of being the son of Dr. Calderon Guardia. In 1948, Calderon Guardia was president of Costa Rica and was supposed to end his term by transferring the power to the democratically elected new presi-
dent. However, Calderan Guardia did not cease dent. However, Calderon Guardia
power and a civil war erupted, led by Jose Figueres, power
to attempt to secure the democratic system. Castillo, the presidential candidate for the ruling PLN, has a doctorate in economics and was
recognized as the man with the knowledge to deal recognized as the man with the knowledge to deal
with the economic crisis at the beginning of the with the economic crisis at the beginning of the
1980s, when he was president of the Central Bank. 1980s, when he was president of the Central Bank.
Castillo relies on the 38-year-old political machinery of the PLN.

Hotline provides outlet for students
 Interchange, a student hotline at
Texas Tech, responds confidentialfly and seriously to calls concorncerning sex, roommate conflicts, possible
suicides and basic campus informasuicides and basic campus informa-
ion, said Raquel Contreros-Ramos, coordinator of the Interchange program in the Counseling Center.
The service began in 1975 as an information program. Students would
call with questions concerning the call with questions concerning the
university, such as football schedules, tuition payment infermation or organizations on campus,
she said. she said.
ed a need for hing Center recognized a need for a hotline to handle per-
sonal problems, she said, so the insonal problems, she said, so the in-
formation line incorporated a crisis line.
"The line handles crises, but students can just call in informally
just to relate to another person," Ramos said.
Most of the workers on the line are college students. "They are not experts, but training for a profs-
sion that requires a lot of contact with people on a social level," she said.
Ramos said that with the help of
an assistant, she screens a student an assistant, she screens a student
with an interview to determine the student's level of thinking.

immunization clinics through the middle of March.
"We don't see this as a small probelem," Haley said. "There are large numbers of unimmunized preschoolers. We can offer immuniza-
tion clinics, but if the parents don't bring their children to the immunization clinics, we're kind of helpless."
Other counties with outbreaks but with fewer reported cases are Bexar, Brazos, Denton, Erath, Harris, Hill, Hutchinson, Kaufman, Warrant, Travis, Van Zandt, Webb and
Wharton.
