Apparently the faculty may be intending to come
out of its shell.
Efforts have been made by the Faculty Council to
improve its communication with the administration.
It should be pointed out that the efforts are to improve
communication - with emphasis on the idea that
communication is a two-way street.
As reported in our front-page story today, some
faculty members are convinced that the
administration is totally deaf to the needs, wishes or
requests of the faculty. So, the faculty requested and
got faculty-administration breakfasts at which
selected faculty members meet with a few
administrators to discuss various issues. Some
reports have it that faculty members do not think the
set-up is worthwhile.
Perhaps the committee for faculty-administrative
communication, under Dr. Pearson's direction will be
able to work out more satisfactory means of
guaranteeing sincere consideration of faculty
grievances.
Something is needed. Often, The University Daily
will contact faculty members for information and get
nothing - particularly on crucial matters such as
budgeting, which is a real sore spot among Arts \&
Sciences faculty. If any information on such critical
matters is ofered it's always preceeded by something
like, "Now, don't print this, but...".
Unfortunately, that's worthless when so many of the
faculty members insist that their views be withheld.
The matter of budgeting is almost purely opinion.
The head of this journalism department has resigned
because of budgeting questions. Despite constant
rumor that the faculty is really in uproar over the
money situation, few of them will go on public record
in opposition.
Maybe now, that faculty committee will get fellow
faculty members to go on record with their stands
which heretofore have been somewhat private.
