Texas Need For Growing One Variety of Cotton Shown

No matter what one may think of William L. Clayton

cotton grower would be served by growing as neary one
variety as can be done profitably, and by making more careful selection of seed than has been the custom in the past. That is good sense. Any person who grows crops of ways the most profitable for if quality be neglected the additional labor required to haryest the quantity will make
the profit much less than if quality were given first con sideration.

will oroduce better
