operation since January 1, was discontinued April 1, 1911 by Act of Congress. The Post Office Department presently is uquidating its accounts and on July 1, 1967, will transfer all unared assets of the System
he Treasury Department. The decision to abolish the Oostal Savings System was made
because of declining interest in it by the general public as a savings and investment medium. Higher interest rates paid by fimeans of investment had attracted the bulk of funds which formerly went into Postal Savings and gated by expanded hours of ser-
The original purposes of (1) get money out of hiding, attract the savings of Immigran Who were accustomed to saving
at post offices in their native countries, (3) provide safe depositories for people who had lost confidence in private banks, an
