- A worthless check written for less than ${ }^{5} 5^{\circ 0}$ could result in a $\$ 200^{\circ 0}$ fine.
- A worthless check written for from ${ }^{5} 5^{\circ 0}$ to $\$ 2,0^{\circ 0}$ could result in a 180 -day jail sentence and/or a \$1,000 fine.
- A worthless check written for from s2000 to $\mathbf{s} 200^{\circ 0}$ could result in a year in jail and/or as 2,000 fine
- A worthless check written for from s200up to \$10,000 could result in a prison sentence of from 2 to 10 years and/or a ${ }^{5} 5,000$ fine.
