Her favorite foods are pizza, broccoli and chicken. She will be escorted by Jordan Jay Scitern, her best friend.



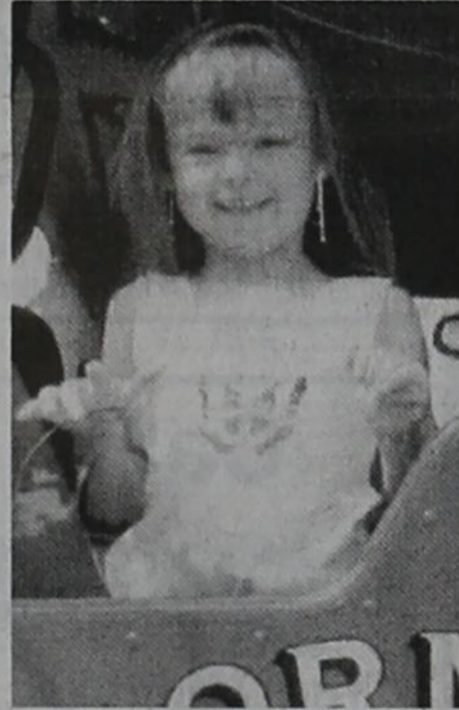
Michaela Brooke Burns

Tour of the Peanut Country Bike Ride June 9

The eighth annual Tour of the Peanut Country Bike Ride will be Saturday June 9. The ride, sponsored by the Gorman Lions Club and Gorman Volunteer Fire Dept., will start from the City Park promptly at 8 AM with no starters any later than 9 AM. There are four distances to choose from: 9 mile, 29 mile, 45 mile or 100K. These courses will all have several rest stops with water, Gatorade, fruit, cookies and peanuts to replenish the riders. There will also be Sag Wagons available should anyone have any mechanical trouble or need medical assistance.

Anyone interested in registering may do so by phone at 254-734-3810. Registration will open on tour day at 7:30 am, at the Start/Finish at City Park. Entry fees are as follows: \$22 for individuals, tandems--\$20, Families of 4 or more--\$20, Clubs (4 or more members)--\$20. All proceeds from this ride benefit the Gorman VFD and the Gorman Lions Club for local projects and scholarships.

Eastland Co. To Offer Drug Card

Eastland County will soon be introducing a discount card program to help consumers cope with the high price of prescription drugs. The county has signed a contract to make free prescription drug discount cards available under a program sponsored by the National Association of Counties (NACo) that offers average savings of 20 percent off the retail price of commonly prescribed drugs.

The cards, which will be available June 11, 2007 may be used by all county residents, regardless of age, income, or existing health coverage. An estimated 100 percent of the county's pharmacies will accept the NACo card, and a national network of more than 57,000 participating retail pharmacies also will honor it.

"The NACo prescription discount card will offer significant savings for the uninsured and underinsured residents of our county, and even those fortunate to have prescription coverage may use the card to save money on drugs that are not covered by their health plan," said County Auditor Loretta Key. "Residents do not have to be Medicare beneficiaries to be eligible for this program."

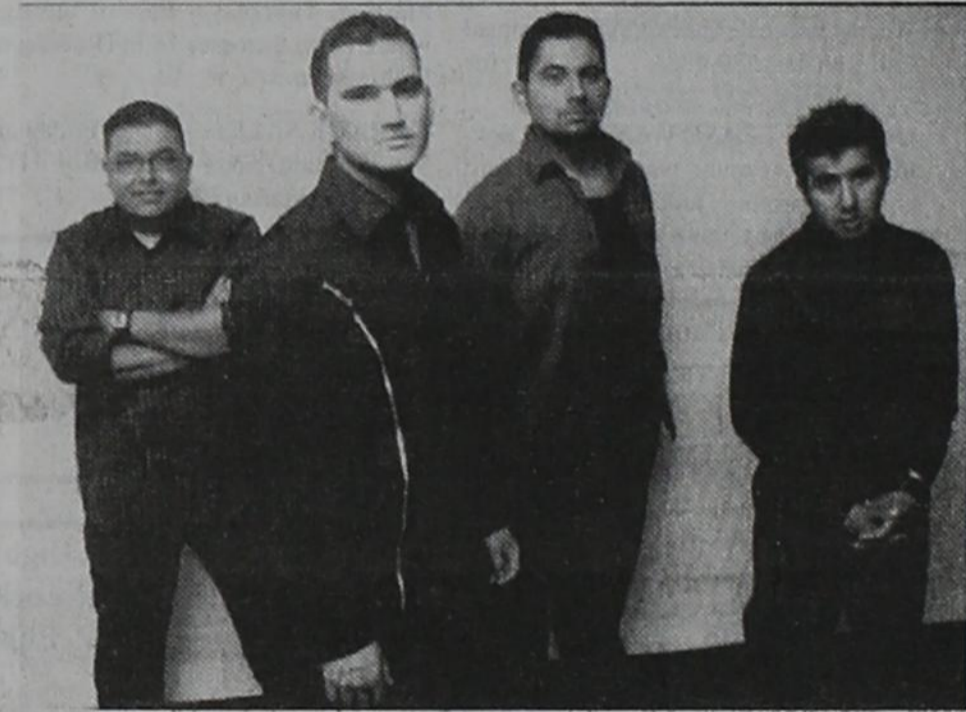
There will be no cost to county taxpayers for NACo and Eastland County to make these money-saving cards available to residents. A future announcement will specify how and when residents may obtain the cards.

"Using the NACo prescription discount card is easy," said Mrs. Key. "A cardholder will simply present it at a participating pharmacy. There is no enrollment form, no membership fee and no restrictions or limits on frequency of use. Cardholders and their family members may use the card any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance."

The discount card program is administered by Caremark Rx, Inc.
