## Arbor Day by Gynnalyn

Arbor Day, a day set aside to celebrate and encourage the planting of trees, was first established over and plant a a tree. You don't have to look very hard to find some trees that didn't survive our recent weather. We all hope the rain starts back soon but a young tree doesn't require much water and is a gift that keeps on giving for years.

Arbor Day is related specifically to public relations. In reality, the best time to plant a tree is in the fall months when the tree is not blooming. This gives the tree a chance to expand and produce strong roots because the soil stays nice and warm despite the blistery conditions above ground. There's never really a bad time to

The Internet serves as a great but tricky resource. Google searching a description of a tree or shrub then clicking images will net a plethora of pictures, some of which may be incorrectly tagged. Double and triple check the information you find on the Intemet to verify the identity and name of the specimen you are after. Also, take a picture and bring it to us so we can help you not only identify
