Six Texas Firefighters Honored at National Fallen Firefighters Memorial Sevvice Gregory Mack Simmons to be Remembered October 6-7 at Official National Ceremonies in MD

EMMITSBURG, MD - The 31st Annual National Fall en Firefighters Memorial Service will honor seven Texas firefighters who died in the line of duty. They are among the 80 firefighter who died in 2011 and five firefighters who died in previous year who will be remembered at the official national service held a the National Fire Academy in Emmitsburg, Maryland on Sunday October 7.
Firefighter Gaston A. Gagne III, age 46 , of the Baytown
Fire Department died within 24 hours after respanding Fire Department died within 24 hours after responding to sev-
eral emergency calls on July 26,2011 Lieutenant Todd W. Krodle, age 41, of the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department died from injuries age 41, of the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department died from injuries
sustained after falling through the roof at a residential structure fire on August 14, 2011. Firefighter Elias Macias-Jaquéz, age 49 of the Cactus Volunteer Fire Department died from burn injuries sustained while operating at a wildland fire on April 20, 2011 Lieutenant Larry G. Nelson, age 61, of the Val Verde County Rural Fire Department died after falling from a ladder while performi
maintenance work at the station on August 12, 2011. Firefighte maintenance work at the station on August 12, 2011. Firefight Chris K. Pham, age 35, of the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department was
found unresponsive after responding to an emergency medical call and later died on June 23, 2011. Firefighter Gregory Mack Simmons, age 50, of the Eastland Fire Department died after being struck by a vehicle during a wildland fire on April 15, 2011.

The names of those firefighters who died in the line of duty will be added to the National Fallen Firefighters Memorial on the Academy grounds. The national tribute is sponsored by the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation (NFFF) and the Department of Homeland Security

More than 6,000 people, including Members of Congress, Administration officials and other dignitaries, members of
the fire service, and families and friends of the fallen firefighters will attend the event. Families will receive flags flown over the U . Capitol and the National Memorial. Members of the fire serS. honor guard units and pipe and drum units from across the U.S. will participate in this national tribute.
