Damage of at Least $\$ 35,000$ Sustained; Low Water Pressure
and High Wire Fence Contribute Lo Soread of Flames,
Which Start in Garage.
Fire of unknown origin early this morning swept the yards
of the Mid-Kansas Oil company and the producing department
of the Texas company, lying between the Melvin road and the
Texas \& Pacific tracks, destroying a large garage and ware-
house, together with all contents and damaging other property.
A conservative estimate places the combined loss of both com-
panies at more than $\$ 35,000$. The loss is supposed to have been
fully covered by insurance. The Mid-Kansas company's loss
on the garage building, two automobiles, a truck and a number
of old tires was estimated at approximately $\$ 10,000$, at the com-
pany offices this morning. Officials. of the producing depart-
ment of the Texas company were unable to place any estimate
on their loss until an inventory had been taken, but it is expected
to be more than twice that of the Mid-Kansas company.
