**WORLD'S RICHEST MEN WILL MEET IN TULSA**

TULSA, May 30.—More billions than would be required to pay the debts of the World War will be represented here in October when the delegates to the International Petroleum congress are assembled. Not only will officials of all the big American oil corporations be present, but practically all of the many rich individual producers and refiners of the country.

In addition to these there will be the delegates from 31 foreign countries who have been invited by America to participate in the world wide gathering of petroleum business men. British, Dutch, Japanese, Mexican, South American, Persian, Burmese, Russian and other foreign interests will be represented by delegates appointed to attend the congress and take part in the discussions scheduled.

**HENRY FORD INVITED TO BUILD MILL IN CISCO**

CISCO, May 30.—Having heard that Henry Ford proposes to build a cotton mill, Secretary Richardson of the Cisco Chamber of Commerce has wired him an invitation to locate his mill in Cisco. The telegram read: "Henry Ford, Dertoit, Mich.: "Forty-eight per cent of the state's cotton crop is produced within a 150-mile radius of Cisco, Texas. Cisco's new dam will impound 15 billion gallons of water. Cisco is an important railroad center. Cisco has an abundance of cheap natural gas. **HOLSTEIN COW MAKES RECORD FOR BUTTER**

CHICAGO, May 30.—California Pieterje Bloom Mead, a pure bred Holstein cow, owned and bred by the University of California, has just completed a year test which makes her the sixty-seventh Holstein in the United States to produce over 1,000 pounds of butterfat in one year. In 365 days she produced 28,236 pounds of milk containing 1,004.62 pounds of butterfat, according to official announcement from the Holstein association of America. This fat production is equal to 1,255.77 pounds of butter.

**FRUIT BUTTER.**  
1 pound fruit.  
3-8 pound sugar.  
3-8 pound Karo.  
Water to cover.  
Time, 3-4 to 1 hour.  
Cover fruit with water and cook till soft. Rub through a coarse strainer. Add sugar and Karo and cook till thick (adding spices to the taste).

**SPICED FRUITS**  
7 pounds fruit.  
1 cup vinegar.  
2 pounds sugar.  
2 pounds Karo.  
3 ounces of cinnamon and cloves (Tied in bag.)  
Wash fruit and remove skins. Cook pulp till seeds may be removed by pressing through strainer. Put all together, including skins, and cook till thick.

**FRUIT JUICE DRINKS**  
To juice prepared as for jelly making, add syrup made as above to the taste, sterilize and seal in sterilized bottles to be used as a fruit juice drink. Grapes, especially the small black Spanish variety, make a delicious unfermented drink, just tart enough to be refreshing. Other fruits may be used in the same way, according to preference.
