WASHINGTON, Aug. 23.—The world market situation for wheat next year may not be as favorable as hitherto for marketing the export surplus on account of large planting in this country and certain foreign countries, the agricultural department said in a report today.

"The carry-over of old wheat next season may be larger than this season's carry-over, but there is a tendency to continue to expand the wheat area, not only in the U. S. but also in Canada, Argentina and Australia," declared the report which is being widely distributed as a warning to wheat farmers.




