Escobar's first attempt at charitable kindness occurred when he attempted to prevent a big man from striking a little man in a South El Paso lunch room.

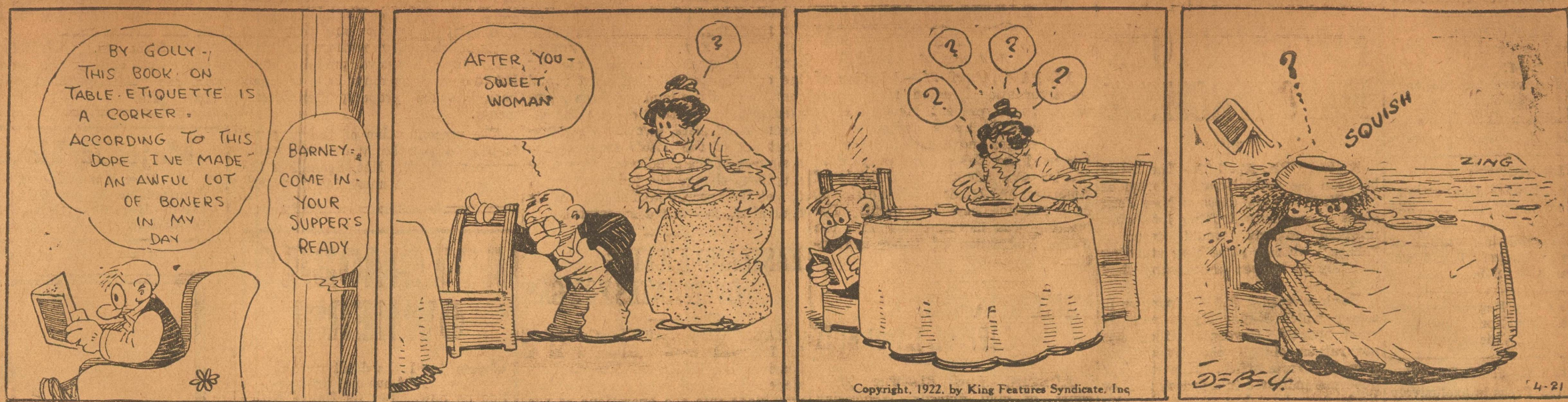
Soon thereafter Escobar was walking in a B C alley. He noticed that the harness on a mule had become tangled about the animal's feet.

CREATOR OF SHERLOCK HOLMES ARRIVES IN AMERICA TO TALK ON SPIRITUALISM

NEW YORK, April 21.—Certain heretofore "unknown details" of life in the spirit world have been given to reporters by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, famous as an author of mystery stories. It appeared that he must have been consulting his favorite character, Sherlock Holmes, for he was most specific.

Here are some of his statements: Spirits live on one plane for thirty to forty years, then if well behaved they go to a higher plane.

Suicide is no short cut to the spirit life of happiness. During the suicide's residence in the first spirit plane all the mental states that im-

graphed this substance and that when it passes from the medium it assumes a putty-like color. The spirit entering the zone containing this gas becomes visible, he said.

The British author declared that not only had mediums disclosed his dead son to him, but he had seen his mother and that every wrinkle was clearly to be seen as he had known them during her life.

The happy plane of the spirit world he designates as "Summerland." It is his idea of heaven and he says every one is happy there. On the other hand, he says, the grossly material persons who give no thought to the better things of this or any other life go to a place which he

designates as "purgatory."

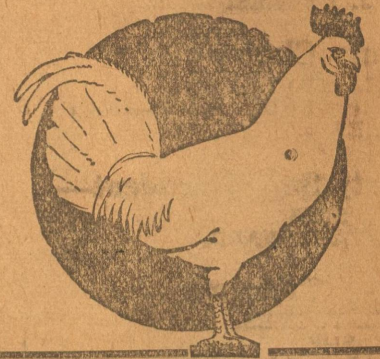
Hard to Keep Out!
