## Parmer Has 3405 Voters

For the 1970 election year, Parmer County has a total of 3,405 registered voters, according to figures registered by the office of County TaxAssessor-Collector Hugh Moseley
with the Secretary of State. with the Secretary of State.
The 3,405 filgure gave Parmer a registration percentage of 78.85, according to an announcement from the State Democratic Executive Committee in Austin.
