## Fillet of Beef with

1 center cut piece beef tenderloin (approximate weight 2

## $1 / 2$ tsp. salt

$1 / 2$ tsp. freshly ground pepper
1 tbs. vegetable oil
2 tsp. peanut oil for searing
1 ts. mininced shallots
3 tbs. dry Madeira win
$1 / 2$ c. beef bouillon
2 oz. creamy Roquefort cheese
4 tbs. unsalted butter, softened
3 tbs. heavy cream, whipped until stiff
2 tbs. lightly toasted pine nuts
2 tbs. lightly toasted walnut pieces
2 tbs. toasted sliced blanched almonds
2 tbs. toasted sliced blanched
1 tbs. chopped fresh parsley
Salt and pepper meat, then rub vegetable oil over the surface. Keep meat refrigerated, loosely covered with plastic wrap. One hour before cooking, remove from refrigerator and
bring to room temperature. In a large heavy- bottomed skillet. heat peanut oil and clarified butter until very hot. Sear meat on all sides (about 4 minutes). Transfer meat to a wire rack or grid; let rest a minimum of 20 minutes. Discard cooking fat. glaze. Add the beef bouillon and bring to a boill. Reduce to a syrupy consistency. Scrape into a smaller skillet, if desired. Set aside. Beat the Roquefort and butter in a small bowl until smooth and refrigerate. About 30 minutes before serving, preheat oven to 450 degrees. Fanish beef fillets on a rack in the oven: 18 minutes for rare 19 minutes for medium-rare. Meanwhile, gently reheat the syrupy sauce in the skillet; swirl in cheese and butter mixture one spoonful at a time. Fold the whipped cream into the
