appraisal district office.. or you may draft a similar form.

Who must file a rendition? You must file a rendition if you own tangible personal
property that is used to produce income - such as the property that in used to produce income-s

Are there any advantages to you?

- You give your opinion of your property's value. If the
appraisal district believes the value is higher, it must appraisal district believes the value is higher, it must
notify you in writing of the higher value and explain notiry you in writing of the higher value and explain
how you can protest that value to the appraisal review

You record your correct mailing address so your tax
bills will go to the right address. If your bill is mailed to the wrong address, the law still holds you responsi-

- You can also file a "report of decreased value: to notify the appraisal district of significant Tepreciation of
the value of your property in 2001. The district will look at your property before assigning a value in 2001 .

What's the deadline? The last day for filing 2002 renditions is April 15. Call may be postmarked, if mailing. You can get an extra 15 days if you ask for it in writing by the April 15
