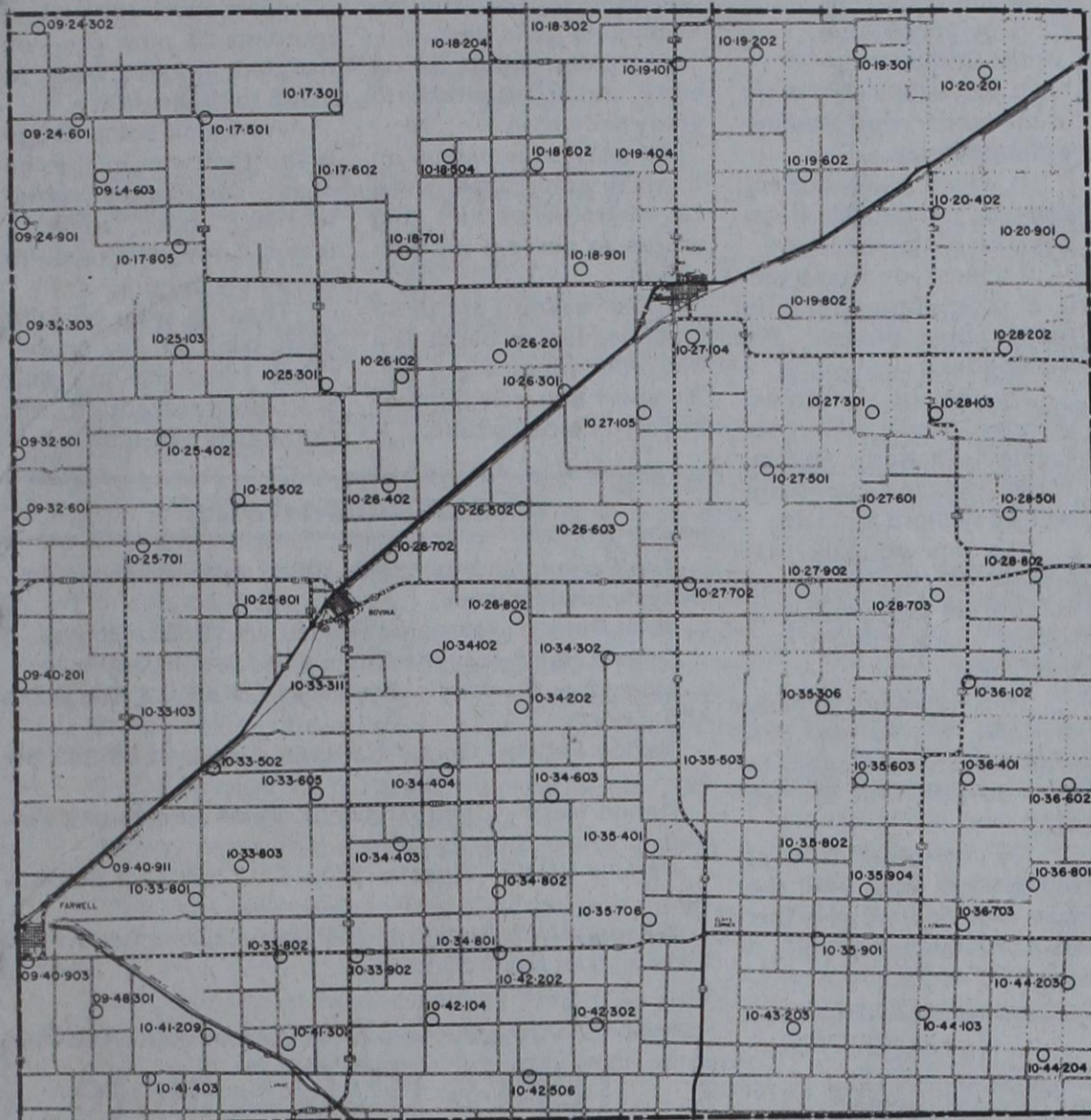

Parmer County ground water levels declined an average of 1.89 feet during 2002. This is based on measurements taken from 95 privately owned wells in the observation network maintained by the High Plains Under-ground Water Conservation District No. 1.

Ground water levels in Parmer County declined an average 2.39 feet annually during the 10-year period from 1993 to 2003. An average decline of 2.11 feet was recorded for the 5-year period from 1998 to 2003.

Ground water levels in the Ogallala aquifer within the 6.8 million acre water district service area declined an average of 1.06 feet from 2002 to 2003. This decline increased by 0.28 of a foot as compared to the previous year.

All counties in the water district's 15-county service area saw an average decline in depth-to-water levels. Don McReynolds, High Plains Water District geologist/technical division director, said, "This decline is probably due to a number of reasons, but primarily, a lack of precipitation at opportune times resulted in the requirement of additional ground water pumpage last year."

In Bailey County, the ground water level decline .41 feet from 2002 to 2003. The average change from 1993 to 2003 was 1.09 feet. The average change from 1998 to 2003 was .97 feet.

Hale and Parmer counties, plus portions of Castro, Deaf Smith, Lamb and Potter counties, within the water district recorded average water level declines of more than one foot.

Bailey, Cochran, Lubbock and Lynn counties, and portions of Armstrong, Crosby, Floyd, Hockley and Randall counties within the water district, reported an average decline in water levels of less than one foot.

The water district maintains 95 observation wells in Parmer County and their results are listed below:

Weather takes a toll on county

The rain, wind and hail that struck Parmer County this month have taken a heavy toll.

Monti Vandiver, crops extension agent for Parmer and Bailey counties, estimated that at best 50 percent of the cotton planted in Parmer County is still in the field.

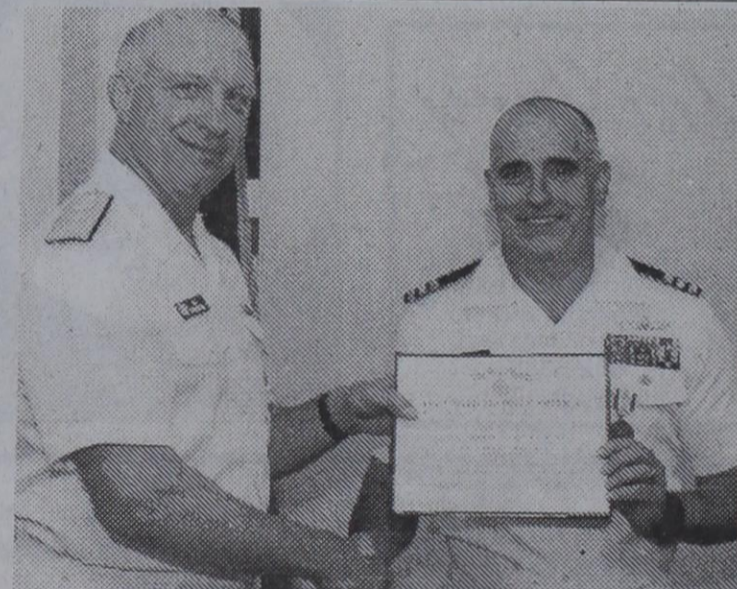
And of that total, up to 20 percent might not work out.

Since it's too late to replant for cotton, farmers are looking to plant grain sorghum, soybeans, blackeye peas, or go to early wheat, then let cattle graze.

It's not only the hail that has caused damage. High winds, around the 60 miles per hour mark, did strong damage to stalks, too.

Asked about Bailey County, Vandiver said their totals are similar to Parmer County.

But for those who just look for rain totals, the

moisture that has fallen on Parmer County this month has been great.

Last Friday, about 1 1/2 inches of rain fell on Farwell.

Lonnie McFarland, manager of the AGP Grain Cooperative elevator at Lariat, said for the 10-day period, 1.85" of rain fell there.

And here are the Lazbuddie totals, thanks to Ted Treider:

June 1, .52"; June 3, .37"; June 4, .55"; June 5, .80"; June 9, .30"; and June 13, .90"

And even though the sun was shining brightly in Farwell on Tuesday, a light rain was coming down in Lazbuddie.

The Texas Cooperative Extension Office reports that the "best guess" estimate of damaged cotton resulting from violent weather in West Texas this month is between 500,00- and 725,000 acres.

The raw potential economic value of those lost acres was put between \$130 million and \$188.5 million.

Texas farmers plant about 5 million cotton acres each year, stretching from the Rio Grande Valley to the Texas-New

Mexico border, and as far north as some counties near Amarillo.

The 20-county area surrounding Lubbock is often known as the "world's largest cotton patch" because farmers there typically plant about 3.2 million acres of upland cotton.

About 10 percent of that acreage, about 320,000 acres, never makes it to harvest due to weather, insects, disease or other causes.

Producers hardest hit in this area by violent weather were Floyd, Crosby, Hale, Swisher, Parmer, Castro, Bailey, Cochran, Lamb, Lubbock, Terry and Yorkum counties.

2003 cotton crop has taken a big hit in our area

What's good for the goose isn't always good for the gander and evidence of how true this old saying is, is easily found on the Texas High Plains after several rounds of intense West Texas weather.

So far, conventional wisdom categorizes an estimated 500,000 acres as unsalvageable victims of hail, wind and rain. Add in another 500,000 acres or so suffering varying degrees of damage from back-to-back-to-back thunderstorms, and potential losses in 2003 acreage and production potential could be staggering.

On the heels of the storms that have ravaged cotton fields in PCG's 25-county area, many producers are making the decision to re-plant to other crops or stick with cotton. Either way the outlook for 2003 has taken a significant hit.

The flip-side of the coin, however, is that the same storms that wreaked havoc on early May-planted cotton fields have opened the door for overdue dryland producers.

As many irrigated producers weigh their options north of Lubbock, the dryland decision-making process for producers south of Lubbock is shaping up as more of a foregone conclusion - plant cotton.

As the remainder of June shapes the 2003 crop, producers need to keep in mind that the current situation will also impact ongoing boll weevil eradication efforts. Producers are encouraged to keep failed cotton fields free of hostable cotton throughout the growing season.

2002-Crop Figures Released by NASS

Final figures on the 2002 crop show the Texas High Plains produced 3,245,600 bales on some 2,825,900 harvested acres in the 25 county region served by Lubbock-based Plains Cotton Growers, Inc. Overall, 2002 production was a significant 752,900 bales better than what the area produced in 2001.

Abandonment totaled 756,300 acres in 2002 while harvested acreage increased some 400,000 acres over 2001.

Yieldwise, the High Plains averaged 551 pounds of lint per harvested acre in 2002. Irrigated cotton averaged an impressive 748 pounds per harvested acre while dryland yields averaged 263 pounds per acre in 2002.

The 748 irrigated yield figure marks the highest average irrigated yield in 25 years and only the third time in that same time period that irrigated yields have eclipsed the 700 pound mark. Irrigated yields in 1993 averaged 716 pounds and were followed by a 706 pound irrigated average in 1994.

The following table shows the official National Agricultural Statistics Service production figures for the 25-county Plains Cotton Growers, Inc. service area.

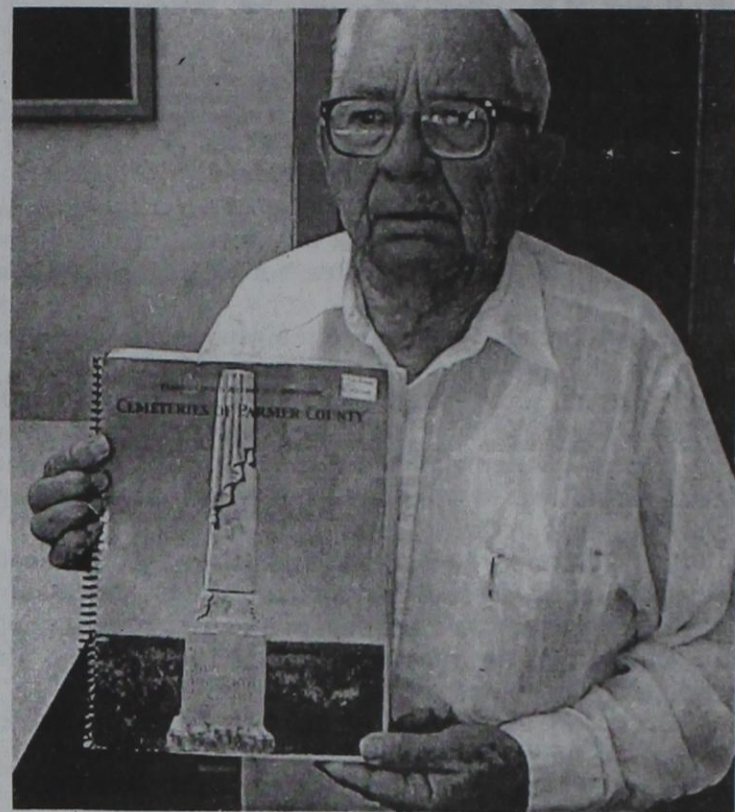
The 194-page book is available for \$15 at Farwell City Hall and at the Parmer County clerk's office in the Parmer County Courthouse in Farwell.

A special note to newcomers to this area: Farwell has two cemeteries. The one in use, called Sunset Terrace Memorial Park, is adjacent to the Amarillo highway.

But the original Farwell cemetery, located along the State Line Road about two miles south of town, is called Olivet Cemetery.

Olivet Cemetery includes a group of graves with names from families like Hamlin, Overstreet, Kindred and others who helped start the Twin Cities of Texico and Farwell.

Just inside the gate and to the left are the graves of Susie Hassell and her eight children, buried by the community on Christmas Day 1926 after they were axed to death by their husband and father, George, in Parmer County's most sordid crime.

'On to Berlin' was key phrase

If you want to see a patriotic issue, you ought to see Page 1 of the July 12, 1918, issue of the Texico-Farwell News.

This issue came out toward the end of World War I, which ended, as we all know, at 11 a.m. on Nov. 11, 1918.

Over several headlines throughout the issue were the same three-word slogan: **On To Berlin.**

The issue carried a small article that directly affects today's newspaper: it told of the new zone system of newspaper postage, whereby publishers pay postage on newspapers according to the percent of advertising contained in each issue, and at different rates according to the zone to which the paper is sent. These rules remain the same in 2003.

Another Page 1 story was headlined "Near Panic at Criterion."

Someone cried "fire" at a religious patriotic service at the movie theater. The cause was -- some little boys were playing outside when one bumped into a trunk rack on a car, which cut his forehead. The boy apparently who cried "fire" got a "skinning" by his folks.

Some folks attended a cowboys reunion and 4th of July gala in Las Vegas, N.M. One Farwell lady became fascinated with the town and prepared to move to that "best city in New Mexico."

The weather, as always, was a hot topic. Consider this:

"Veterans G. Washington Landers, G. Clark Smith and M. Marshall Craig seated on the curb Wednesday evening in front of B. Ostrum Faville's cold drink parlor, were discussing the new moon -- hanging just above the western horizon -- and its influence on weather precipitations. Standing at its almost perpendicular tilt, with scarcely enough hook to hold the Indian's powder horn, it was viewed by Veteran Craig as a "dry" moon. Veteran Smith contended that this tilt would spill the water, consequently a "wet" moon.

"When reminded by the News listener that while dry here it is, it was daily raining in Illinois, Veteran Landers interposed that "it was a different moon" visible in Illinois. In fact, the trees were so tall there the moon was not visible before the first quarter."

Here's another interesting article, in light of today's animosity toward the French for their Iraqi stance: "Ob-

servance of July 14, the French National Day, by the United States as a legal public holiday, is proposed in a resolution offered in the U.S. House of Representatives today by Rep. Siegel, of New York.

It didn't pass. Page 2 featured ads for the State Line Motor Co., which was pushing dry cells for general ignition at 45 cents each; Southwest Utilities, of Farwell, for electrical demands; the Santa Fe Railroad, for all-year tourist fares; and the print shop operated by the News.

One article said that "Parmer County farmers to the east and south are muchly interested in the road crossing of the railroad on the road leading to Muleshoe. This is a very steep and bad crossing, and the farmers have petitioned the county commissioners for an "under" crossing. It is said the railroad dump is well suited for the "under" crossing, and that Parmer County commissioners will consider the change at a special meeting to be held on Saturday.

Wonder if this is the FM 145 "underpass"? The county commissioners also were petitioned by the farmers to have the rabbit bounty act, which was recently rescinded, reinstated. It is said that rabbits are again devastating crops.

Bet you didn't know that rabbits were a serious Parmer County problem years back...

Page 3 again contained a full page ad urging folks to buy stock in the Cannon Ball Motor Co., which was operated by the Times owners. Since this was the same information noted in a previous article, it won't be repeated.

One paragraph, though, was interesting: "The automobile business has grown to gigantic proportions. A few years ago, there were 150,000 cars in use. Today, there are 4.5 million. No man dares estimate what the next 10 years will bring in this wonderful industry. The demand for trucks is many times the supply. The day is near at hand when the tractor industry will



LIVE CATTLE: The seasonal tendency over the last 15 years has been to move lower from June 5th into the 20th. This seems to be the case this year, but prices have sold off sharply over the last couple of weeks even in the face of huge discounts to cash. Most of the sell-off has been more technically related than fundamental. The market should find support around current levels and rally from here into July. The seasonal turn-up 14 out of 15 years into July from June 22nd.

FEEDER CATTLE: Prices dropped along with the fed cattle and Live Cattle prices this week, but this market has held up much better. The seasonal tendencies also turn higher from late this week into July and these levels should provide support similar to the Live Cattle prices?

CORN: Prices took a hard hit on Friday along with the entire grain complex. The market was able to pull back and hold support around the \$2.39 area basis the July contract. Short term trends are still up, but a close below \$2.38 would turn trends down once again? Great weather in the Mid West has added pressure, but sharply lower world stocks has many concerned about supply problems.

SOYBEANS: Short term trends turned down on Friday and prices have checked support levels at \$6.10 basis the July contract. Ideal weather conditions in the Mid West has been attributed for most of the selling pressure. Demand remains strong, but trend line yields may keep a lid on the market until something fundamentally changes the current direction?

WHEAT: This market fell along with the rest of the grain complex on Friday. Up until then, prices had been holding up fairly well, but short term trends are now down. The seasonal tendency is hard to beat when prices usually fall into harvest such a high percent of the time. Extremely tight ending world stocks are still helping to support the market even though we're off our highs?

COTTON: Prices have reached the 56 cent level basis the July contract and have yet to break convincingly above. A solid close above this level could push the market back up toward their April highs of \$60.75-61.00 basis the July contract. Heavy losses in the Texas South Plains area have generated almost a 9 cent rally in just the last 6-8 days. This market may have found a temporary resting spot?

Parmer County agencies receive 'call delivery' draft

Pam Nielson, of the Panhandle Regional Planning Commission, has put together a draft for Parmer County Emergency Service providers, as a follow-up to the May 8 meeting in Bovina where the county's 9-1-1 procedures were discussed.

At that time, it was agreed to create and provide the Friona Police Department with a detailed account of how the dispatcher should contact each agency and other instructions on call delivery.

Friona police serve as the 9-1-1 answering point for Parmer County.

The meeting came about after problems in how emergency units were dispatched to Lazbuddie area calls.

Following are some of the provisions in the draft. County agencies now will have a chance to view it, then give their opinions on changes, if needed.

If anyone has suggestions on changes and/or improvements, please send them to Ms. Nielson at the Panhandle Regional Planning Commission, PO Box 9257, Amarillo TX 79105.

It should be emphasized that the following is just a draft; no final decisions have been made yet.

Grievance Procedures

All Parmer County Emergency Service Providers are committed to providing the best possible service and one tool in improving service is review of incidents and correction of any action that may have delayed response. Grievances shall be reported as soon as possible, preferably within a few hours of the incident. If it is not possible to report a problem within hours, the problem is to be reported the morning following the incident.

Grievances may consist of failure of the dispatcher to correctly relay information pertaining to an emergency call, failure on the part of the emergency service provider to communicate with the dispatcher,

Grievances shall be handled in the following manner:

1. All grievances must be specific. Provide the date, time and time of the incident as well as the names of involved individuals and a method for contacting involved parties.
2. The chief administrator of one agency shall contact, by telephone, the chief administrator of the other agency within 2 hours of the incident.
3. If it is not possible to report the incident within 2 hours, the report shall be made as soon as possible and at least by the morning following the incident.
4. If either chief administrator is unavailable, that administrator shall appoint someone to assume responsibility for reporting grievances.
5. Immediately following the report of a grievance, both individuals involved in the report shall submit to the other a written document outlining the incident, any suggested policy changes and any suggested solution to the problem.
6. Once a determination has been made, one document outlining the incident and the corrective action shall be prepared, signed by the chief administrator of each agency and a copy shall be provided to any involved agency.
7. If approval of any action is required by another body, such as the County Commissioners or City Council, the chief administrator of the agency requiring approval will assume responsibility for getting such approval.
8. In the event the involved parties are unable to resolve the difficulty, a meeting of the Parmer County Emergency Services Providers (PCESP) shall be called as soon as possible. Each agency shall have at least one member at the meeting and that member must be capable of making decisions for the entire agency. The purpose of the meeting is to establish a solution that meets the needs of all involved.
9. Solutions provided by the PCESP shall be documented in writing in and signed by the involved agencies. Each agency shall keep a file containing such documentation.

Emergency Service Zones

Within Parmer County, emergency service zones have been established by mutual agreement between area emergency service providers. An emergency service zone is the official designation of the proper law enforcement, fire and emergency medical service that is responsible for providing service in that area. These emergency service zones are the basis of the establishment of emergency service numbers (ESNs), which are utilized to program the 9-1-1 system to automatically relay a 9-1-1 call to the proper answering point. In addition, ESNs provide the dispatcher with the necessary information needed to dispatch the correct agency.

Unless there is some recognizable error in the ESN and services providers displayed when a 9-1-1 call is received at the Friona Police Department, the dispatcher shall dispatch the agency indicated on the 9-1-1 record. If no ESN is

displayed, such as when a wireless call is received, the dispatcher shall be responsible for obtaining from the caller the address of the incident, landmarks or crossroads and attempt to match that information to the ESN map.

Decisions of this sort shall be made to the best of the dispatcher's ability to locate the caller. All parties involved recognize there may at times be errors in determining the appropriate emergency provider but all parties agree to address any problems as indicated in the grievance procedure and not to the dispatcher involved.

Changes to the ESNs can be made only through a meeting of all area emergency service providers, involved elected officials and involved administrators. Changes must be communicated to the Director of the Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network as soon as possible. Changes will not go into effect until all database entries and maps have been corrected by the Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network staff.

Lazbuddie Fire & EMS

Calls received involving fire and medical emergencies in ESN 306 shall be handled in the following manner:

1. Dispatcher shall verify the name, address and telephone number of the caller. If the location is different than that of the caller, dispatcher shall obtain the incident location from the caller.
2. If the caller is unable to provide an address, dispatcher shall obtain directions to the site of the emergency.
3. Dispatcher shall obtain from the caller the nature of the emergency such as structure fire, grass fire, automobile accident, suspected heart attack, etc.
4. Dispatcher pages Lazbuddie Fire & EMS by:
 - a. change channel by hitting the Lazbuddie button twice;
 - b. press Lazbuddie paging button;
 - c. after tones cease, key the microphone and state the nature and location of the emergency;
 - d. upon receiving the page, Lazbuddie Fire & EMS shall reply to the dispatcher indicating they are in route;
 - e. once on the scene Lazbuddie Fire & EMS shall again notify the dispatcher;
 - f. if incident involved an ambulance run, Lazbuddie shall notify dispatcher that they are transporting or if no transport is required.
 - g. Lazbuddie Fire and EMS shall notify dispatcher one last time once they are back in service.

If no response is received to the initial page, dispatcher shall

1. approximately 5 minutes after the initial page is issued, dispatcher shall page again;
2. if no response is received to 2nd page in approximately 5 minutes, dispatcher shall begin escalation procedures.

Law enforcement center to cost about \$3.1 million

The Parmer County Commissioners held a special meeting on June 11 to meet with Danny Butler, the construction manager at-risk, who is heading the new Parmer County law enforcement project.

The commissioners reviewed the bids he had awarded, then confirmed them. The total bid was \$3,157,236, including \$100,000 for contingencies. Butler said he hoped the final total would be less than the \$3.1 million.

Here is how the construction breaks down:

Site work, Lipham Construction, \$61,055; concrete work, Gay & Son, \$243,500; plumbing, Pierce Plumbing, \$199,500; flooring, CAS, \$34,957; finish millwork, CAS, \$25,490; HVAC, Howard Mechanical, \$266,160; electrical, Freeman Electric, \$317,600.

Also, fire alarm system, ISI Detention, \$76,641; fire alarm system, ISI Detention (under the electrical bidder); detention doors and windows, ISI Detention, \$217,000; CCTV, ISI Detention, \$24,157; drywall, rough carpentry and lay-in, CAS, \$127,963; masonry, Gay & Son, \$430,000; tape, bed, texture and paint, Commercial Industrial Builders, \$68,990; fire standpipe and sprinkler, A&C Fire Protection, \$116,900.

Also, building accessories, CAS, \$35,828; structural steel and roof, Davis & Hawkins, \$297,225; detention furnishings and equipment, ISI Detention, \$43,117; steel detention ceilings, A&C Construction, \$50,000; rollup door and operator system, CAS, \$88,398; kitchen equipment, Kirby Restaurant Supply, \$88,398; and fence, \$8,000.

The total construction cost came to \$2,745,081. Other costs were: contingency, \$100,000; DVCI reimbursable, \$120,000; and construction management, \$192,155,000.
