## Registration under way for bicycle contest

All youngsters are reminded that registration is open for the Border Town Days Decorated Bicycle Contest.

Youths must sign up at the Tribune, 404 3<sup>rd</sup> St. in Farwell.

This year offers some extremely nifty incentives

-- Two brand new bicycles are being given away. Tedson Trailers and Master Tech Auto Service both of Texico, have donated the two bicycles.

-- One for a boy and one for a girl!

This year's BTD theme is "Strike Up the Band - The Wonderful World of Music." It is very important to follow the theme since that is a large part of judging.

The judging is done by Clovis residents recruited by the Clovis Chamber of Commerce.

Also, an anonymous donor has provided funds for cash prizes to be given away in each category.

"Everything is ready at the Tribune for kids to register," said Linda Moss, who once again will honcho the annual bike contest. And, once again, she is being assisted by Joy Stanton.

The registration deadline for the contest is at 3 p.m. on July 29.

Mrs. Moss said that youths planning to enter the contest need to register, giving their name and age, to be eligible for all

the prizes.

The contest will be held one hour before the Border Town Days parade kicks off on Saturday, July 31. The contest takes place adjacent to the Citizens Bank branch in Texico.

After the bicycle contests ends, all participants will ride in the parade to the Farwell City Park.

Prizes will be announced at the beginning of the day in the park activities at 1 p.m. cst, at the Farwell City Park gazebo.

All participants need to be on hand at that time to receive their prizes. No motorized bikes are allowed in the contests.

All riders must bring their decorated bikes and trikes to the west side of the Texico branch of the Citizen's Bank building in Texico by 9:45 a.m. Texas time (that's 8:45 a.m. New Mexico time).

Room is available for the contest, and the Texico City Council has approved closing the street next to the bank to traffic during this time. Thus, there will be complete safety for the kids during the judging.

"You must be on time or you will not be judged," alerted Mrs. Moss.

She added, "Contestants need to be sure to stick to the theme - 'Strike Up the Band - The Wonderful World of Music' - if they are going to be counted. The judges

will be looking for adherence to the theme."

The contest is open to all youths who live in the Texico and Farwell School Districts. Also, the BTD committee has voted to allow children and grandchildren of local folks to enter, also, even if they live elsewhere.

The contest is open for youths from 6 to 12 years of age.

Other rules are:

-- All participants ride in the parade. Their folks can go along, too. The parade ends at Farwell City Park and a bicycle rack will be set up just across the street on the property of First Baptist Church of Farwell.

-- Riding bikes in the park during BTD is not allowed, for safety reasons.

-- You must be present at the park to receive your cash prizes (or if you win the bicycles!) when the announcements are made during the 1 p.m. ceremonies.

## County roads 145, 1731 resurfacing projects draw gov't attention

Folks' complaints about the work being done on two major county roads surfaced at Monday's meeting of the Parmer County Commissioners.

The commissioners told of those complaints to David Harper, assistant area engineer for the Texas Highway Department at Littlefield.

The two county roads are 1731 and 145.

The state has finished resurfacing 1731 from Bovina to Lariat.

But in some cases, asphalt has peeled off, and in others, the newly-resurfaced road is higher than connecting roadways, causing "dips." This can cause vehicles to "bottom out."

As for 1731, Harper said the state plans to re-surface part of the Smith's Corner area again.

Also, work will be done to help some homeowners' driveways around five miles north of 145, to eliminate some of those "dips."

As for 145 (Oklahoma Lane to Lazbuddie), complaints have been about the new road not being as smooth as folks would like.

Harper said there are no plans to do extensive re-work here, but they will use rollers to smooth out some spots, and do some patching.

The 145 resurfacing is now taking place in Lazbuddie, and will continue to FM 1055.

Harper estimated about 8 months work is left on this project.

Asked what caused the roads' problems, Harper replied that it was a combination of high temperatures, high humidity and slow traffic.

He explained that when asphalt is first put down, it is tender, then becomes more durable later.

So at first, large trucks tend to "stick" to the asphalt when they drive slowly, adding to the problem.

In other business, the commissioners:

-- Approved the annual \$10 road and bridge fee for each vehicle registered in the county.

A list of where all the boxes can be found is elsewhere in today's Tribune.



They would snarl at each other, stalking each other as they walked around and around the ring. The crowd, us included, began to chant "kill 'em, kick his rear, take down the Empire Man."

Of course we supported the Empire Man's opponent, Homer the Humiliator. When the bell rang, the two wrestlers ran toward each other and butted heads. They both simultaneously fell to the mat, out cold. The referee initiated the 3 counts and disqualified both wrestlers.

The night was going rather quickly, more quickly than the sponsors counted on, and they began to try to think of ways to fill in the time remaining. They came up with the bright idea of asking volunteers from the audience to step in and 'rassle each other for the fun of it.

Wilbur, caught up in the emotion of the night, quickly jumped up and shouted, "I'll do it!" My jaw dropped to the floor. Here was Wilbur, all of 130 lbs ... soaking wet, volunteering to get his brains beat out.

Wilbur went down faster than the time I accidentally let go of a huge tree branch and whacked him right across the face. He lay on the mat, screaming about the pain in his nose. The way he was screaming made the crowd begin to chant "Puny, Puny, get up Puny."

I began to laugh at the crowd, not noticing what was happening in the ring. The older man picked Wilbur up and hurled him over the top rope, right into my lap. I was quite surprised at what happened, spilling my soda all over the front of my shirt and pants. The crowd then began to poke fun at me, claiming I had an "accident" in my pants.

## Gibbs, Wauson win 4-H recognition



## Crystal Heart

(Editor's note: Crystal Stover, daughter of Jerry and Colleen Stover, of Farwell, is on a mission trip this summer. She is sending the Tribune periodic reports.)

Hey guys!

The past few weeks have been crazy and very busy. The time here has gone so fast. I have only two and a half weeks left before it will be time for me to come home. Here is one incident that I would like to share with all of you.

Last Sunday, I was getting ready for church and preparing to do a skit in church, when a lady came in all bruised up. Her eye was black and blue from being punched and her upper thigh was black and blue because she had been kicked.

This woman sat by me when church began. I could tell that she was hurting inside and out because every time I would hug her, she would just start crying and say thank you for being nice to her and for being her friend.

The lady said she lives out in the woods with her boyfriend. They live under a tent. She told me that she has been abused for 10 years but never had the guts to tell anyone because she was afraid he would get mad and kill her if he ever found out that she had told.

She has been coming to this church, (North Main Street Baptist) and every time she came to church she would be bruised and beaten, she told me.

One time she wanted to come to church, and he didn't want her to, so she said he chained her to a tree for two days. She had no food or water for those 2 days, she said.

This whole situation is a very sad and dangerous one. She goes to the rescue mission and works for food stamps, but when she brings home the food stamps her boyfriend makes her go out and buy beer for him, she said.

On one occasion he demanded that she bring him some water from the river. She was physically not up to it, so he drug her to the river and pushed her under and held her until she almost drowned, then picked her up just so he could do it again, she told me.

This past Sunday as she shared her heart with me, she admitted that she could not take the abuse any more. Pastor Nick talked to her and asked her if she was indeed ready to get out of this situation. She admitted that she did not know if she could have him arrested. But as I write this, the man is indeed in jail.

I decided to make this my project to see what help is available to this lady and to others who are addicts, not only to drugs, but to anything, including abusive situations.

There is a National Program called Teen Challenge. This program can be accessed on the Internet for anyone who would like more information.

I had an idea that I could involve my church and my community. I got the lady on a waiting list for this program. Okay, there is a glitch; it costs \$1,000 to be in this year long program, which really is inexpensive because this program is so extensive.

I am asking Farwell to come together and show someone they don't even know that they care for them. If anyone would like to help financially, please contact Russ Ponder, Rhonda Kirkland or Colleen Stover. I want you all to know how much I love all of you and I would appreciate anything that you are willing to give.

### Farwell city taxes likely to stay the same: Mace

The Farwell City Council on Tuesday approved the proposed 2005 fiscal year budget, which is basically the same as the current year. Thus, taxes are expected to stay about the same, said Mayor Jimmie Mace.

The budget includes 3 percent pay hikes for city employees. It was noted that the ambulance has been paid off, and the newest fire truck will be paid off in November, thus meaning less funds will be needed in those accounts.

In other business, the council:

-- Heard that Police Chief Robert Achterberg is putting out notices to folks who have allowed weeds on their properties to become a problem.

-- Approved building permit applications for David Cochran, a new house at 401 Fifth St., and for Jesus Parra, to enclose a carport at 200 2<sup>nd</sup> St.

-- Heard a request from Joe Pena to seek an extension on bringing up to code a house he moved into 9<sup>th</sup> Street about 7 months ago. He was not at the meeting. The council asked that he appear at its August meeting, and to show that some work is being done, or he will be cited.

-- Called an executive session at Mace's request for personnel reasons.

-- Had discussed limiting garage sales in the city. This was due to a business on Avenue A that was holding them on a regular basis. But City Clerk Cynthia Thigpen said the business has applied for a sales tax permit, so this topic has been dropped.

-- Agreed to revise the noise ordinance to have church bells ringing be excluded from the decibel levels cited in the current ordinance.

-- Noted complaints about the lack of EMS personnel in Farwell. Mace said this was due to folks not wanting to commit on a weekly basis to attend meetings.

So I picked up the telephone and called Washington, D.C. To make a long story short, it only took 2 or 3 dialings, until I got the right federal office.

So the guy says, "No, it's not a legal requirement for a school to publish this notice in a newspaper. The only legal requirement for the school is simply to send it to its local newspaper."

So I called back the superintendent with that info, and the good news that the school didn't have to waste money on publishing the lengthy notice.

And I have maintained that same practice with our local schools here. They send me the notice, and it gets put in a proper place. At no cost to the school.

One of the things that has amazed me over the years here, though, is that some schools don't know about these rules, and send them to newspapers - thus spending money they didn't need to.

## Bovina City Council conducts public budget hearing

The Bovina City Council on July 8 conducted its annual public hearing on the proposed budget.

One resident had a budget question. Norma Whitten asked about exactly who will be affected by the sewer rate proposed hike.

Folks in town have water hookups, and some also have separate sprinkler water charges. The proposed rate hike, estimated at \$22 a month per connection, only affects the former.

The council took no action on the proposed budget since this was a public hearing only. The council will vote on the budget at its Aug. 12 meeting, at which time the tax levy likely will be known after the Parmer County Appraisal District "crunches the numbers."

The proposed budget includes:

- Three percent cost of living adjustments for city employees.
- \$30,000 for a new hydraulic drill to clean sewers.
- \$30,000 for two new trucks for the public works department.
- \$50,000 for street sealing, a regular expenditure for most years.
- \$18,000 as the city's contribution toward the First Street paving project.

Speaking of the paving project, the council voted to go ahead with this work - with contingencies.

Here's the situation:

The cost for paving 1<sup>st</sup> Street and some adjoining streets is estimated at \$48,000. The city is willing to pay \$18,000 toward the work, with participating property owners paying the other \$30,000.

Now the ball rests in the property owners' court. They have been given a deadline of January 2005 to collect

enough contracts from those involved in order to get to that \$30,000 amount.

If that total isn't reached, the council likely will take a second look at the project and perhaps will cut it back - or not do it at all.

For example, based on comments from some of the folks living on the adjacent side streets, it's unlikely that the side streets will be done. If so, that means the project cost will go down.

In other council news:

-- The resignation of Zef Villarreal was received. He was a city maintenance worker, building code inspector and animal control officer.

-- Heard Ann Corn complain of animals roaming free. The other day, she was out in her cart with her dog, and she said a pit bull came between them. Her dog won the battle. But the animal problem is still here, although it's better than it was a few years ago, she noted.

The council put the animal control problem on its August agenda. Currently, Fire Chief Cesar Marquez is "in charge" of it (see article in Becky London's column).

-- Also put on its August agenda are two other topics:

1. Protocol for the police use of tasers. Police have purchased tasers and received training last week on their usage.

2. A possible slaughterhouse ordinance. A couple of folks in town kill pigs on their property. A question has risen about the safety issue if the blood runs into the street gutters.

-- Passed a resolution to cancel the certificates of obligation it planned to seek to pay for the proposed sewer project. Instead, the city is looking at two other avenues which would finance the job at a lower interest rate - the (1) Texas Water Board and (2) Rural Development.


