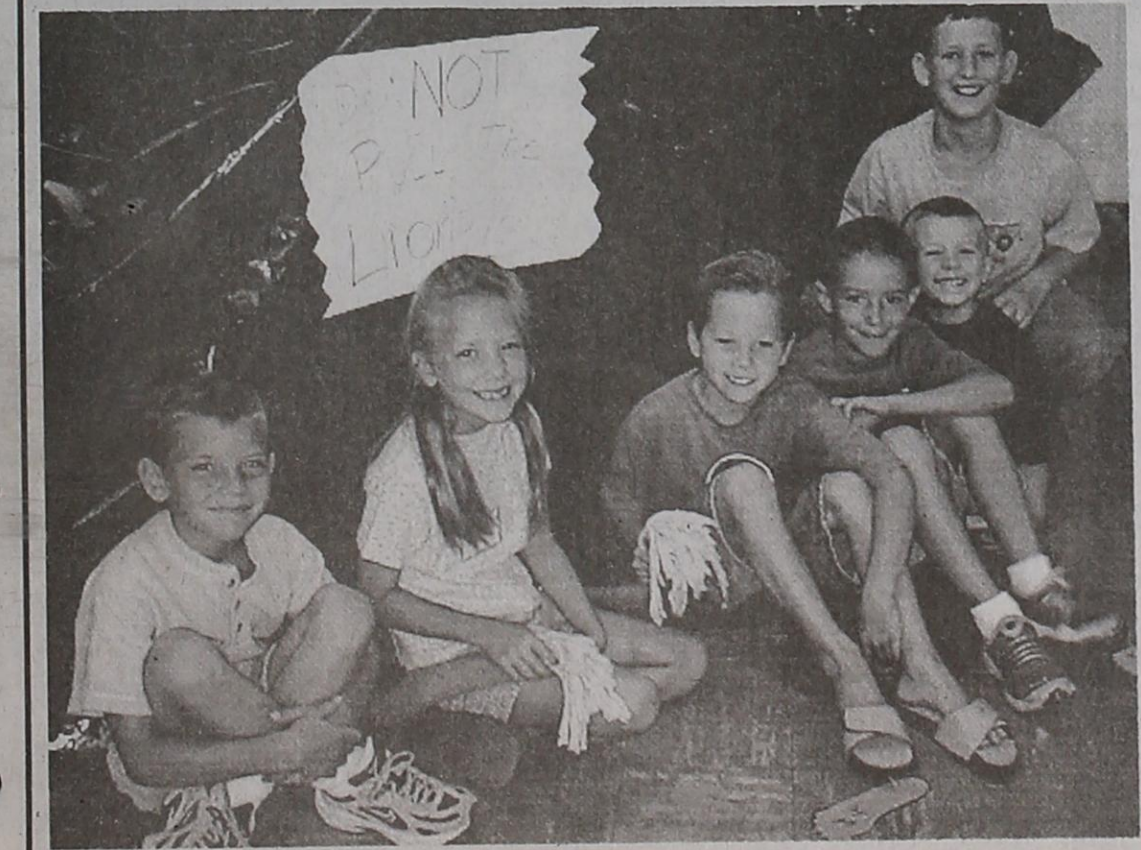
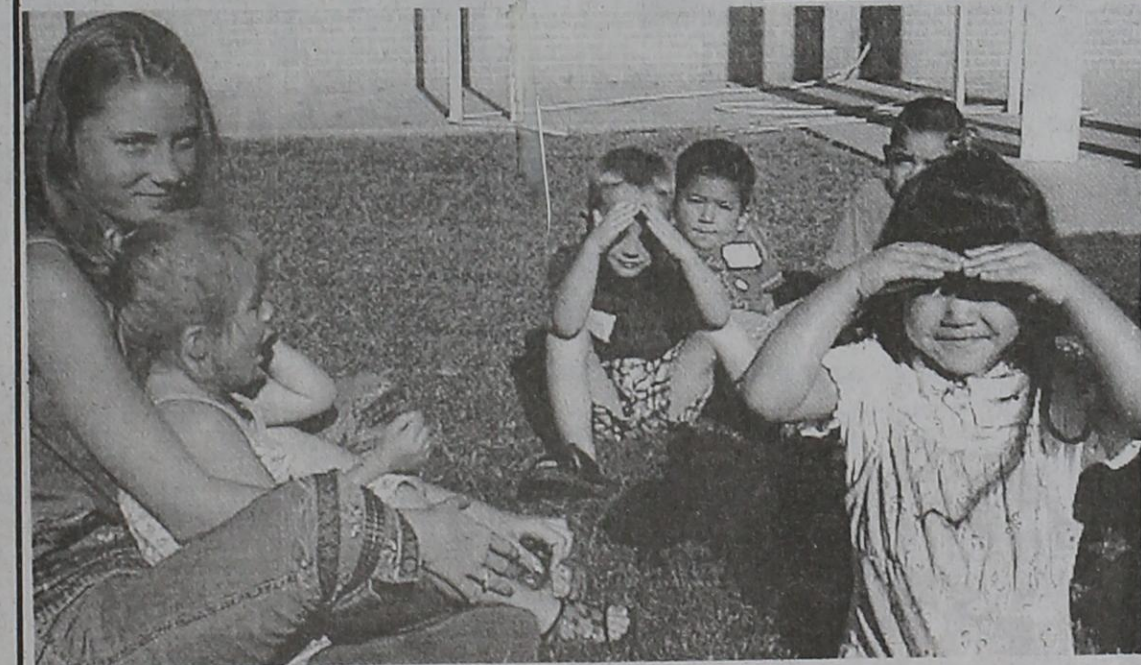

## Ground-breaking held for the new Texico gym

The official ground breaking for the \$3.4 million Texico Schools gymnasium took place on Aug. 3.

Honorary ground breakers included state Rep. Anna Crook and state Sen. Shirley Bailey.

To be built is a 1,200-seat gym, plus locker rooms, concession stands and restrooms.

The concession stands will be used for football, volleyball and track.

The new gym will virtually double the amount of seats available to sports fans, since the current gym houses around 600 persons (plus room for the teams and scorer's table).

And plans call for all 1,200 seats to have "backs" to them. The cur-

rent gym just has bleachers, without backs. Elderly folks, especially, appreciate seats with backs to them.

So far, the state has kicked in about \$1.3 million to make the project happen. Last year, Texico School District residents passed a \$1.5 million bond issue, also, to help with the cost.

The new 28,00-sq.-ft. facility is expected to open in about 16 months - December 2002.

If that schedule is kept, it means the new gym would be ready in the midst of the basketball season. If so, games would be switched immediately to it from the old gym.

And when the new gym opens, the current varsity gym (called Gym No. 1) would tentatively be used for junior high activities.

So you ask what will happen to the Quonset hut known as Gym No. 2? Although the fire marshal has had a problem with this ancient facility, it is structurally sound.

So the Texico School Board has indicated it

wants to keep Gym No. 2 available, perhaps for elementary school activities. New lighting has been added this year at this gym.

Again, no decisions have been made on the uses for Gyms 1 and 2. They are just in the discussion stage.

Texico School Supt. R.L. Richards thanked "the Lord, the school board, the community, the students, the legislature and the capital outlay council for making the gym a reality for Texico students. They worked together to make it happen."

## Hill: Crop was excellent ... or disappointing

A report from Parmer County Extension Agent Cody Hill:

The 2000-2001 wheat crop was disappointing to some farmers while being

an excellent year for others.

The crop got off to a rocky start due to our exceptionally dry fall.

In many cases, a wheat stand was not established as a result of the dry fall weather.

However, once winter shows arrived we had almost ideal weather for growing wheat through harvest.

Those farmers who were able to get their wheat established ended up with a good to excellent crop.

Cool weather coupled with timely spring rains caused an increase in late tiller production as well as more grain being produced per wheat head.

Insect and disease infestation were minimal throughout the spring.
