## May

Texico's Christina Clark set EPAC records in the discus and javelin throws. A suspected meth lab was raided by police in Texico. Brette Hadley and Lori Richardson won the top honors at the annual Texico FFA banquet. In school board elections, Paulette Foster joined the Lazbuddie School Board and Randy Mitchell joined the Farwell School Board. Valedictorians at area schools were Andy Martin, Lazbuddie; Cherry Mayfield, Texico, and Lonnie McFarland, Farwell. First grade teacher Reta Dunsworth retired from Texico School. The Texico-Farwell Rotary Club gave Paul Harris Fellowships to Ronald Byrd, Tom Nichols and Jerry Monk. Named Farwell High's top athletes were Nikki Gober and Cale Stevenson. Terry Jesko was elected Lazbuddie School Board president. Dru Mayfield and Bryce Bailey were named Texico High's top athletes. John Mares was appointed Texico police chief, following the resignation of Kelley Brophy, who took a job with a California computer company. Weldon Killough resigned as Farwell High principal, and was replaced by Gary Gates.

After a meeting between Parmer County EMS agencies and the Panhandle Regional Planning Commission's Pam Nielsen, improvements were made in the county's 911 emergency response system.

A capital murder charge was placed against a Dumas, Texas, man, in the death of a Friona police officer who was run down by a vehicle.

Jourdan Kirkland was named Farwell Junior High valedictorian, and Buddy Jorde was named Texico Junior High valedictorian.

Tobin Redwine and Shonah Black were named Lazbuddie High's top athletes. Bryn Mayfield and Justin Garrison were named Texico Junior High's top athletes. Zane Johnson received the top Farwell High FFA honor at its annual banquet. Tobin Redwine Bryce Haney, Kelli Harris and Melanie Winders received the top Lazbuddie High FFA awards.

The Farwell City Council hired a part-time animal control officer.

In SWCD honors, Lydia White was named Parmer County Conservation District Homemaker, and her son, Landon, won 1st place in the SWCD poster contest.

Amberlee Steinbock and Chase Timms were named Lazbuddie Junior High Students of the Year.

The owners of George's Gold Strike, an 8-liner business in Farwell, accepted a plea agreement in Parmer County Court.

## June

Lonnie McFarland won Farwell High's Loving Cup; Meagan Norton received the Carlos Nicolas award.

Lorre Haseloff was named Girl of the Year by ESA Sorority.

The "Jane Doe" lawsuit filed against Farwell School, involving former teacher Bryan Goldsmith, was settled out of court. The plaintiffs received \$500,000.

Robert Smith resigned as a Lazbuddie School Board member.

A reception was held for new Lazbuddie School Supt. Roy Baker and his wife, Oleta. The cost for the new Parmer County law enforcement center came in at \$3.1 million.

It was announced that famous vocalist Suzy Gayle would perform at Border Town Days.

Statistics showed that Parmer County ground water levels continued to decline.

A proposal to turn the former Westerner Motel into apartment units was opposed by residents attending a Texico City Council meeting. The variance proposal was rejected

in July.

Lazbuddie School cutbacks were made to keep the budget in the black.

## July

Farwell Schools addressed its shortfalls with various cutbacks being made. Preparations for Border Town Days included a Farwell Band Camp.

Dale Gober resigned from the board of High Plains Underground Water Conservation District.

Lazbuddie's Tobin Redwine was named Texico FFA president. Former teachers Lucille Franse, Farwell, and Ann Liethen, Texico, were honorary parade marshals at the 37th annual Border Town Days. The celebration was highlighted by the appearance of country music stars Amy Grant and Vince Gill, who later performed a special show to raise money for Farwell High scholarships.

## August

A novel, "Liar", was published based on Parmer County's most heinous murders in the 1920s of the Hassell family.

Texico and Farwell Schools reported higher first-day enrollments, but Lazbuddie's was lower.

The Texico City Council approved a water rake hike. Sarah Herington won the "I Dare You" award at the Parmer County 4-H honors banquet.

## September

Lazbuddie Schools changed their lunchroom policies for high school and junior high students to eat at the same time.

The Farwell City Council kept its tax rate unchanged.

Remodeling of some Texico classrooms was announced thanks to a \$200,000 state grant.

Named Farwell Homecoming King and Queen were Cale Stevenson and Nikki Gober.

Curtis Williams showed the grand champion swine at the New Mexico State Fair. Parmer County's tax rate went up, partially to help pay for the new county jail.

# State senate race is on

Parmer County will have a special election on Jan.

Gov. Rick Perry has set the date to fill the Senate District 31 post recently vacated by state Sen. Teel Bivins, R-Amarillo.

Bivins was named by President Bush to be U.S. ambassador to Sweden.

Seven candidates filed for Bivins' post by the deadline. Six are Republicans and one is a Demo-

crat. Parmer and Bailey counties are in District 31. The Democrat filing is Elaine Miller.

Republicans are Bob Barnes, Kirk Edwards, Lee Gibson, Jesse Quackenbush, Kel Seliger

and Don Sparks. The five polling places in Parmer County will be:

Oklahoma Lane Methodist Church; Calvary Baptist Church, Friona; Farwell Community Center; Lazbuddie School; and EMS building, Bovina.



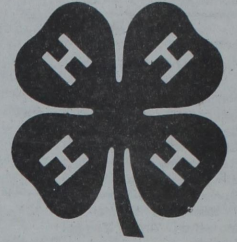

here.

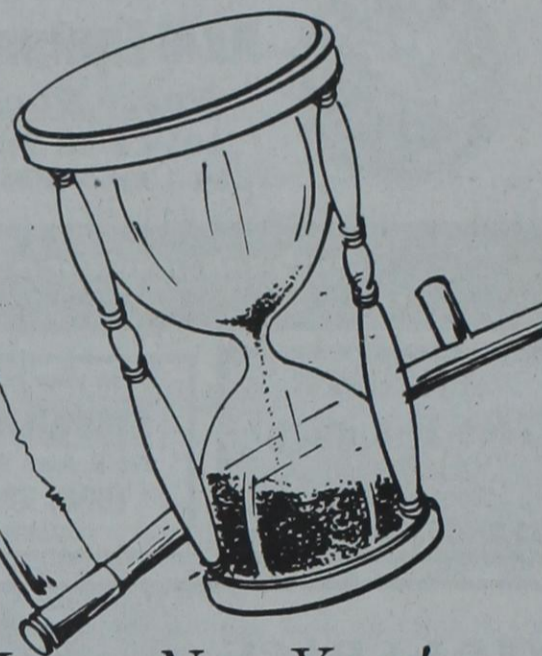
