## Littlefield Withstands Late Rally, Penalties

The Littlefield Wildcat Special is right on schedule, headed for that collision with Floydada, following the Cats' 24-15 victory at Abernathy Friday night.

The Cats withstood a nightmarish fourth quarter to derail the Antelopes and set up the "game of the year" against the defending District 3-AA champions here next Friday night.

Deliriously happy fans, recuperated from a spank from the officials and a furious Abernathy rally, formed a 150-caravan to welcome the Wildcats home about midnight Friday.

The victory gave the Wildcats a 4-1 district mark and left Littlefield the lone serious challenger to Floydada's long standing district domination.

Floydada marched on undefeated in five loop games, scoring a 28-3 win over winless Friona.

Bill Hamblin recovered there, and Littlefield fans went wild.

BUT THEIR CHEERS turned to boos as Official Charles Mayfield ruled Abernathy's possession. The decision brought a lengthy protest from Blakely and continued anger from Wildcat fans.

But Mayfield's decision stood, and the crowd noise continued.

Referee Red Sowder then called for quiet, and got it, but as Abernathy broke the huddle, the roar began building again. That's when he stepped off 15 against the Wildcat fans, and Abernathy kept possession.

The tumult kept building, though, as Riley appeared to fumble and Wildcat Alan Mackey appeared to recover at the Antelope 33.

This time officials, after first indicating Littlefield possession, held a conference and ruled "illegal forward pass". Abernathy retained the ball, but the Lopes couldn't get first down yardage, and punted 51 yards to the Wildcat 4-yard line.

On the first play, Funk fumbled and

## Quail Squabble May Be Averted

Long basel between quail hunters and Lamb County Commissioners' may be averted this year if County Judge Sides is right in his understanding that this entire area's quail has been set at 46 days by the Texas and Wildlife (TP&WL).

Sides said he interpreted from a published article that the TP&WL set the quail season under the

old general law which automatically limits the season to 46 days. But he was quick to add that he had received no official correspondence from TP&WL.

The state game commission usually meets in September and the TP&WL sets the dates on quail hunting. Exceptions to these dates are a few counties that have elected to have hunts set by the county commissioners' court.

For the past several years, the quail season in Lamb County has been set by the Lamb County commissioners' court, with the vote usually tied 2-2 by commissioners and being broken by Judge Sides.

During a regular meeting of the court Friday, Judge Sides said commissioners interpreted the article that this entire area had a 46-day open season on quail this year.

Judge Sides said in an interview last week that he felt that this county's quail season would be no shorter than the 46 days allowed under the general law, and that in the event a longer season is set that he had no idea what the Court would do since there is a new commissioner since the last quail vote.

The next regular meeting of the court is Monday, Nov. 8.

"WE GOT some awfully tough calls in the last quarter," Coach Jerry Blakely said, "but our boys went right on. They gave a tremendous effort, and I think you have to give them credit for doing a job under really tough circumstances."

Littlefield was enjoying its 21-point lead, built on three touchdowns by Ralph Funk and a 31-yard field goal by Larry Hobratchsk, when the roof caved in with two minutes gone in the fourth quarter.

Abernathy, aided by a penalty to the Cat 44, drove for a TD on the passing of QB Steve Riley. The Antelope signal caller climaxed the 8-play drive by completing a 3-yard scoring pass to End Kent Snodgrass. That made it 24-9 with 5:41 left in the game.

Littlefield's next possession saw the Cats get another 15-yard penalty, and only three of its allotted four downs for reasons still not clear.

On fourth down, Matt Giles punted 27 yards to the Abernathy 37, the ball hitting an Antelope square in the back. The Cats'

# She Ran Boarding House

When Mrs. Maud Foster (later Mrs. Maud Street) came to Littlefield in 1924, there were two eating places but no boarding house.

Mrs. Street became a young widow during WWI when her husband was killed just eight months after he joined the Army. With money from the pension, she was determined to make a life of her own. So she built the first boarding house in Littlefield—an 80-foot long, two-storied frame building on Phelps Avenue.

This was in Littlefield's land boom days when land agents brought prospective land buyers in by the car loads.

About 150 people came by for pie and coffee at her opening on a Saturday afternoon in 1924.

She served her first meal the following day. When the big after-church crowd was gone, the new proprietor found the great mounds of mashed potatoes she'd prepared for the Sunday dinner. In the haste and confusion, she'd forgotten to serve them.

During the next four years, 50 to 150 people were served three times a day. Food was put on the tables family style and customers ate all they wanted for 50 cents. "They got their money's worth,"

Mrs. Street said, "because a meal sure was hard to put together."

Fresh vegetables were served during season. Mrs. Street and one of the young girls who worked for her would go out in the country early in the morning to buy fresh peas, beans and corn. "And I'd start shelling the peas or snapping the beans on the way back to town," Mrs. Street said. "I had to, so we could get them cooked before noon. We didn't waste food, either. If potatoes were left from dinner then we served hash-browns at supper."

At times the cooks came and went almost as fast as the boarders. Her best cook had a drinking problem. "When he'd show up drunk, one of the little girls working for me would tie an apron around her head, and we'd get in the kitchen and do the best we could."

"When someone came around looking for a job as a cook, I'd tell him that if he was willing to live in the chicken coop out back for a few days, I'd probably have a job for him."

Roomers paid \$1 a day, with the meals extra. Mrs. Street, or "Ma Foster" as some of her boarders affectionately called her and the four girls who helped her all lived in one of the 11 upstairs rooms, and the other 10 were rented out. "And there was hardly ever a vacant room," Mrs.

Street said.

There was no electricity in Littlefield, so kerosene lamps provided light. All the cooking and heating was done with coal. There was no running water, either, unless there was someone around to run across the street and get it.

At first there was no laundry, and all the sheets were boiled outside in pots, rinsed by hand, dried and put back on the beds.

Mrs. Street bought many of the staple groceries at Lamb County Mercantile the grocery store across the street from the boarding house. J.T. Street and his brother W.G. Street had come to Littlefield in 1913 and put in the store. J.T. was considered Littlefield's favorite bachelor, and the friendship that sprang up between Maude Foster and J.T. Street during the years turned into a wedding in 1928. A few years later, Mrs. Street's first and only child was born.

After four years of running the boarding house, Mrs. Street decided to move the building to 10th Street and make apartments. Top-heavy and too long, the building had to be sawed in half before it could be moved. On moving day the skies opened up and flooded the dirt streets. Alfred Dunagin stuck the truck before he got half-way to the new site with half of the

### Voting-Age Students Must Abide By Residence Law

Voter registration laws, as applied to college students, have caused some confusion. Although the courts have ruled that it is unconstitutional to treat 18 to 21-year-olds differently in the registration laws from the treatment of adults, the old residence law applying to students of any age still stands. Under that law, students cannot acquire residency by living in the college town six months. Their official residence is their home before they became students unless they are prepared to swear they intend to remain in the county after they leave school. The penalty for giving false information on a voter registration application is one to three years in jail. Other means of establishing residence for students would be working year around in the college town or having a wife doing that or paying taxes to the county, all of which could be taken as intent to stay. ## Citizens Earn Wages From Government

How large a segment of the population in Lamb County derives all or part of its income from the federal, state or local government?

How many local residents are holding down public jobs or are getting social security pensions or are getting funds from other governmental agencies?

As in other parts of the country, the proportion of local residents receiving income from such sources is large.

According to computations made by the Tax Foundation, a non-profit organization that reports on the fiscal aspects of government, about 72.8 million people in the United States—more than a third of the nation's population—are getting income from public treasuries.

This covers only those who are receiving general income support. Not included are private institutions and individuals who are being aided by such special purpose programs as farm support, scholarships, job training and other assistance.

The largest single category of Lamb County residents whose support comes from government, in whole or in part, are the social security beneficiaries. As of Jan.

1, they numbered 2,782.

Second in line, in point of number, are public employees. Approximately 650 men and women in the area are on federal, state or local payrolls, according to the latest figures.

Veterans, also, represent a sizeable portion of the people deriving income from government sources. The report shows that 5.5 million of them, nationally, are getting compensation or pension checks from the federal government.

Of those in Lamb County, an estimated 450 living veterans, or survivors of former veterans, are receiving such checks.

In addition, income is going to local residents through various other public agencies. Included are people on the retirement rolls of federal, state and local governments, those who are now in military service and those who are getting unemployment insurance and other benefits.

Even though, as the Tax Foundation points out, some persons may be getting income under more than one program, the validity of the figures would not be affected materially, it states.

## Santa To Get New Wig, Suit

Santa should be able to come to Littlefield in a new suit and wig this year. The D. E. students will decorate a Santa Land in a vacant store building and Santa plans to visit in Littlefield on November 26, 27, December 4, 11, 18 and 23.

In order to finance the continuous Christmas program, at a C-C meeting it was decided that each business should pay 50 cents per front foot of store building in order to be able to finance the Christmas lights, Santa Claus visit, Christmas candy, decorations, and various other expenses incurred during the Christmas program. Present plans are to do this through 1975.

# SWPS To Open New Plant

Clifford B. Jones Station, the newest electric generating facility on the Southwestern Public Service Company's system, will be dedicated at ceremonies to be held at 11 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 6.

The plant is located southeast of Lubbock on Farm Road 3020, just west of the Buffalo Springs Lake Road.

Following the dedication ceremonies, the plant will be open to the public for two days, with the visiting hours on Saturday being 11 to 7 p.m. and on Sunday from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Dr. Clifford B. Jones, president-emeritus of Texas Tech University and a director of Southwestern Public Service Company for more than a quarter-century, will dedicate the new facility.

The response to Dr. Jones' dedicatory remarks will be made by Roy Tolk, president of Southwestern Public Service Company.

The new generating facility

has a first unit capability of 246,000 kilowatts. This machine is the largest single unit on the Southwestern system. Construction has already started for a second unit of the same size, scheduled to be in service in 1974.

When the second unit goes on the line three years from now, Jones Station will be the largest of the 11 major generating stations on the Southwestern system.

The turbine control system at the new station is the first of its type in the world. The result of cooperation in research and development between Westinghouse Electric Corporation, the manufacturer of the turbine, and Southwestern, the system utilizes a digital computer and data recording devices to bring the turbine on the line and control it while in operation. Peter G. Botsonis, a supervisory engineer for Southwestern and a 1958 Texas Tech graduate, played a major role in the development of the control system.

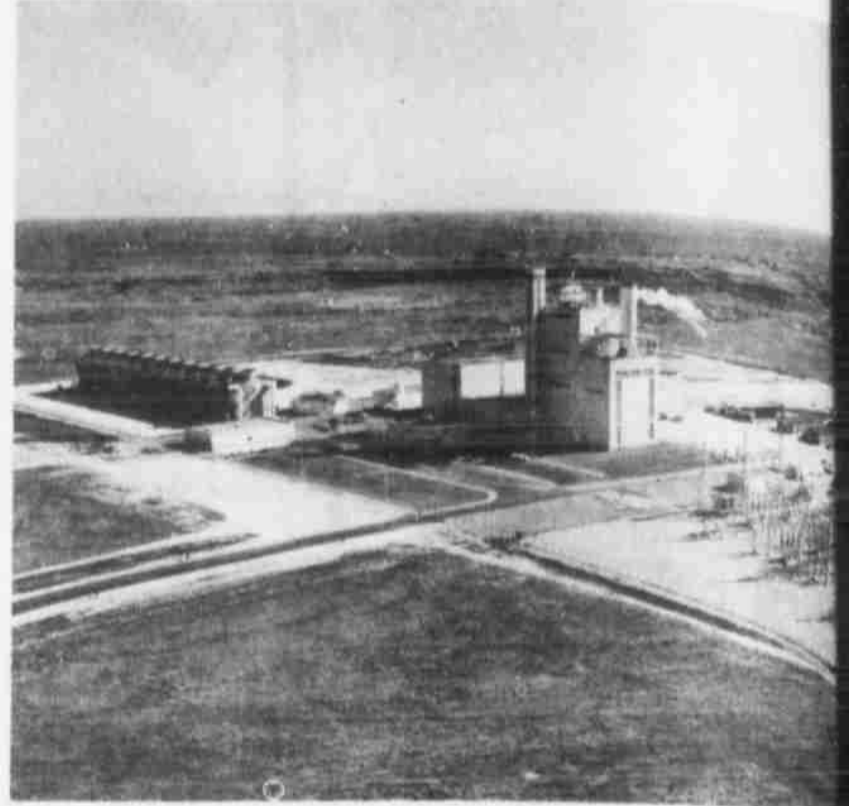
The new facility uses treated sewage effluent, purchased from the City of Lubbock, as its cooling water. In addition, it has equipment which makes it possible to use sewage effluent for the boiler water for test periods of operation.

The sewage effluent is also used for irrigation purposes after it has left the plant system.

The use of the reclaimed water at Jones Station and at Nichols Station on the North Plains results in a daily saving of fresh water which is sufficient to meet the needs of a city of 25,000 people.

The generating capability of Jones Station will be controlled by an automatic dispatching system, which regulates the production of all of Southwestern's major generation facilities.

The automatic dispatching

system knows which generators do their work the most efficiently when everything, particularly the cost of fuel, is taken into consideration. So, the ADS loads up those generators which are most efficient first, and conversely, takes the load off those machines which are least efficient first. The result is that, under any given conditions of electric load—maximum—average—minimum—the electric company is working to provide its customers with the most efficient—and economical—electricity that it can produce.

The plant has a central information system which takes

nearly 500 different readings every minute, records them and calculates their meaning insofar as the plant's efficiency is concerned.

Jones station is located on a 320-acre tract which was formerly part of the V-8 Ranch. It has been under construction for about 36 months and has provided more than \$5,000,000 in payroll and local purchases for the area economy.

While it isn't something you could put together with a "do-it-yourself" kit, the plant is, in fact, a home-made product. The design, engineering and construction supervision was done by Southwestern Public Service

Company's own engineering department, under the direction of H. O. Hodson and Robinson, vice president.

Missouri Valley Constructors, Inc., of Ames, the mechanical and boiler contractor and Babcock & Wilcox Electric Company of N. M., was the electrical contractor.
