City Attomey Opines Some Lesser Increase

| The legal application of General Telephone company of the Southwest for a temporary inment of an existing rate ordinance governing phone service in the City of Littiefield, which If granted would have resulted in immediate raise of rates, filed in District Court about a month ago, was up for hearing before Judge E. A. Bilis in Littiefield, Monday morning. Judge Bille ruled against granting of the asked temporary injunction, and immediately thereafter, set the first Monday in February for a further hearing, which will present and be focused on the merits of the case. <br> As a result of the court's refusal to grant the asked temporary inJunction, subscribers of the Littlefield Telephone Exchange will contine, at least until after next February, to continue to pay the same telephone rental rates, as at present. <br> Following the filing of the legal action here, about five weeikg ago, a mars meeting was beld in Luttlefielk at which, clte, na mapped a campaign and its finaneligg, for oppoeng a requested approximately 50 per cent rate increase. <br> As a result, hundreds of dollars were subscribed to contest the action. Lawyers were employed, and rate analysis experts were employed to study the entire rate structure.
