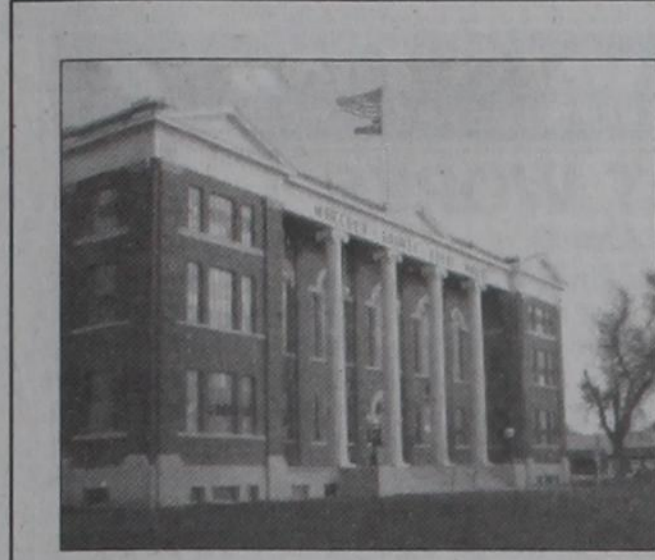

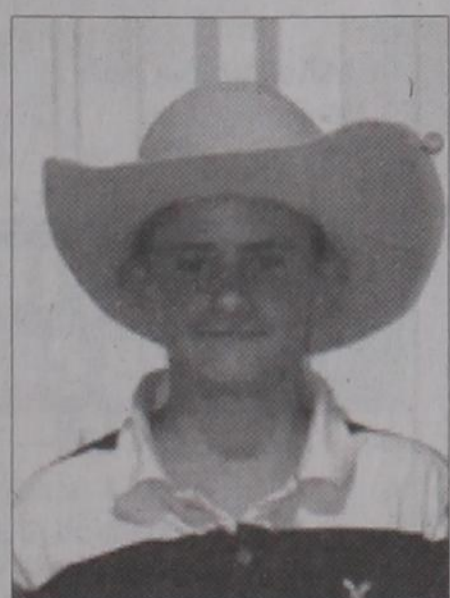
Model Car Contest

Local Fire Departments Respond To Two Oilfield Related Fires Sun.

Wheeler Volunteer Fire Dept. answered two calls on Sunday, May 8, 2011. The first was caused by a mechanical processing unit at a well location and the second was a gas fire ignited by a drilling rig flaring. There were no injuries from either fire.

At 11:28 a.m., the department was called to a fire five miles north of Wheeler on 152 and west on FM592. The fire was the result of vapors igniting from a heater/treater burner engulfing the entire location, including storage tanks, gas piping and processing equipment. Extinguished by 2:15 p.m., the fire was on the west side of

the road and caused zero pasture damage. There was no loss of pasture in the area.

Sunday afternoon at 5:10 p.m., the local firemen were called out to a location north of Wheeler on CR28. Grass had caught fire from a drilling rig flare. With a loss of approximately 10 acres, the blaze was brought under control by 7:15 p.m.

Responding were Allison, Briscoe, Kelton and Wheeler Volunteer Fire Departments.

Please report any suspicious activity in areas of fire ignition to local law enforcement or fire officials.

Commissioners Purchase Equipment For Wheeler County Sheriff's Dept.

The Commissioners' Court of Wheeler County, Texas, met in regular session on Monday, May 9, 2011, in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Wheeler County Courthouse, 402 Main Street, Wheeler, Texas. The prior bills and matters of mutual concern were discussed in a 9:00 a.m. meeting. At 10:00 a.m., the court convened for the purpose of addressing the eleven items on the agenda.

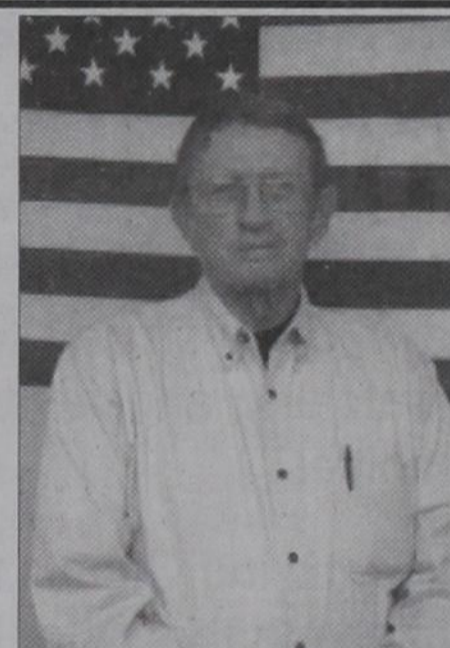
The minutes of the previous meetings were approved as read. Reports from Justices of the Peace Precincts 1&2, Treasurer, County Clerk and District Clerk were accepted by the court.

The hourly payroll time sheets were approved for payment as presented.

The court voted to pay the approved bills. The budget item on the agenda was the transfer of \$125,000 from the county's Road and Bridge General Operating budget to each of the precincts' (1, 2, 3, & 4) Precinct Equipment funds.

No action was taken on the Burn Ban.

The Wheeler County Sheriff's Department requested the county's help with the purchase of Cop Sync computers and program. Six computers (one for each sheriff's vehicle and one for the office) and the programs for their operation would be purchased at a cost of \$21,000. The

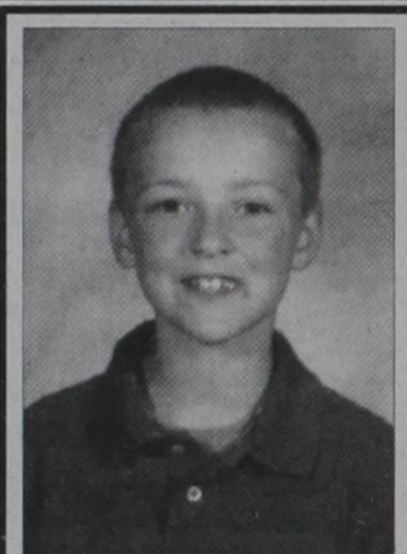

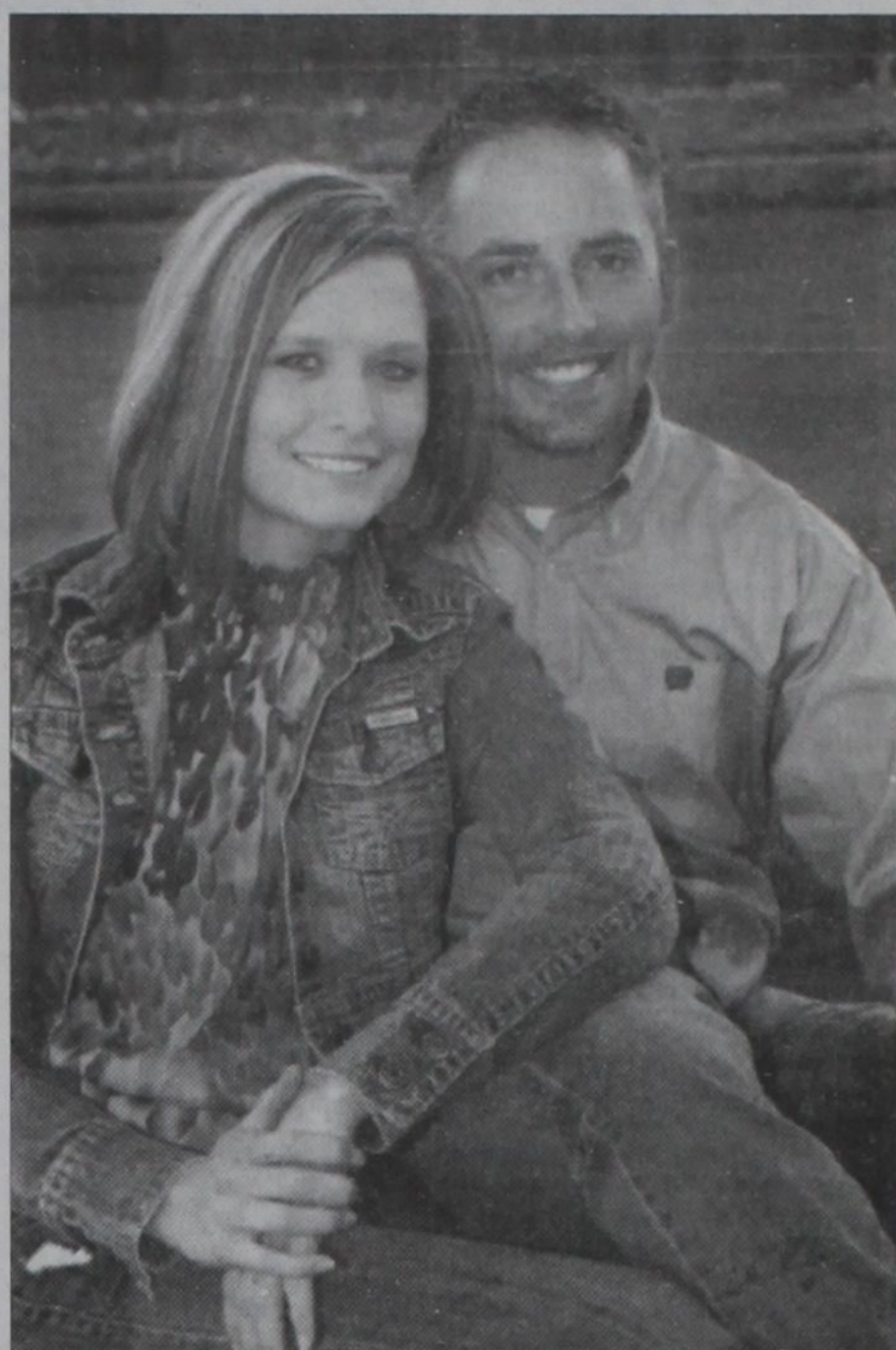


