| I＇ve always been fascinated by old，horse－drawn farm equipmert， dad，was too． <br> ＇ll attempt to explain what these two plows looked like and how they worked．The＂Go－Devil，＂was the one I was most familiar with， the one I was most familiar had because a lot of farmers had taken them to the blacksmith shop （where I liked to hang out some） and had them adapted to fit the three－point hitch on a tractor．They were essentially a two－row sled， with two runners made of $2 \times 6$＇s． There were two boards on each side that would straddle the rows of usually，cotton or maize．Behind the boards was a metal fender that could be raised or lowered， to keep the dirt from covering up the small plants．On each side of the fenders was a small plow that could also be adjusted to furnish the correct amount of dirt to the fenders． <br> Most of the farmers who had one adapted to a tractor，usually left the seat on it，making it right in the center between the rows．．．I |
