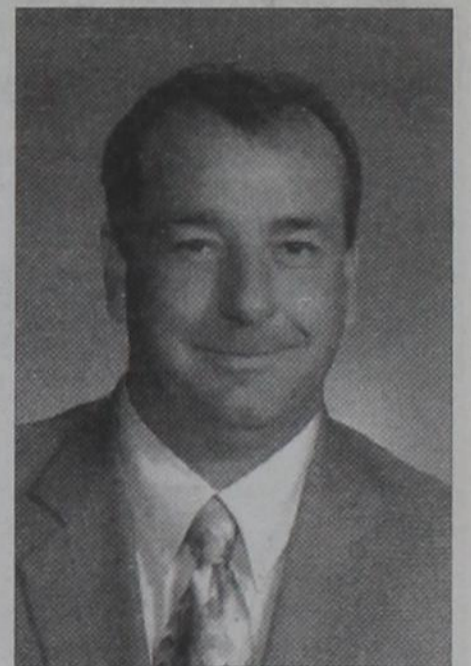
Rites Are Read For Clay Mahler Nov. 1

RATTLESNAKES & COTTON TRAILERS

About this time of year, when I begin to see farmers start gathering cotton, it brings back a lot of memories. One of my favorites, was when our kids were young and we were down here over the weekend, visiting Shirley's folks. Even though we were living in Amarillo, we would come back here about every third or fourth weekend. If her dad was stripping cotton, I'd help him. That just amounted to riding in the trailer behind the tractor and keeping the cotton forked to the back of it. I also, tromped the cotton, so it would hold enough to make two bales at the gin. At this particular time, he hadn't started stripping yet, so the three trailers he had were parked just across the road from their house, in a field he had rented. I don't remember why, but our son Bobby and I walked over

to where the trailers were parked. Just as we got about even with them, I saw a rattlesnake, right in front of Bobby. I grabbed him by his shirt collar and yanked him back so hard I almost gave him "whiplash." I told him, "Quick, go tell Grandpa to give you his 'Snake Charmer' 410 pistol, and a couple of shells, so I can kill this rattlesnake!" "I'll stay here and make sure it doesn't get away." Sure enough, while he was gone, the snake crawled up under one of the trailers. When he got back with the gun, I put in a shell, hunkered down, and let the snake have it. Then I heard an unexpected sound. It only took me a few seconds to figure out what that spewing, whistling sound was. In addition to the snake, I'd also, shot one of his trailer tires. I kind of hated to tell him what I'd done, but didn't get the chance anyway. Bobby ran to the house and told him, before I could get there. Instead of being mad about it, he thought it was downright funny. As a matter of fact, he would mention it nearly every year, along about "cotton stripping" time. He sure got his money's worth out of that old trailer tire!

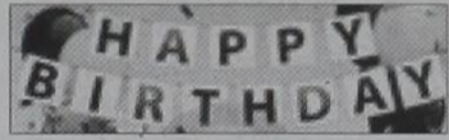

Bud, Carol and Chesley Scribner were at Maurita's party. Their daughter Carol Ann, brought them.

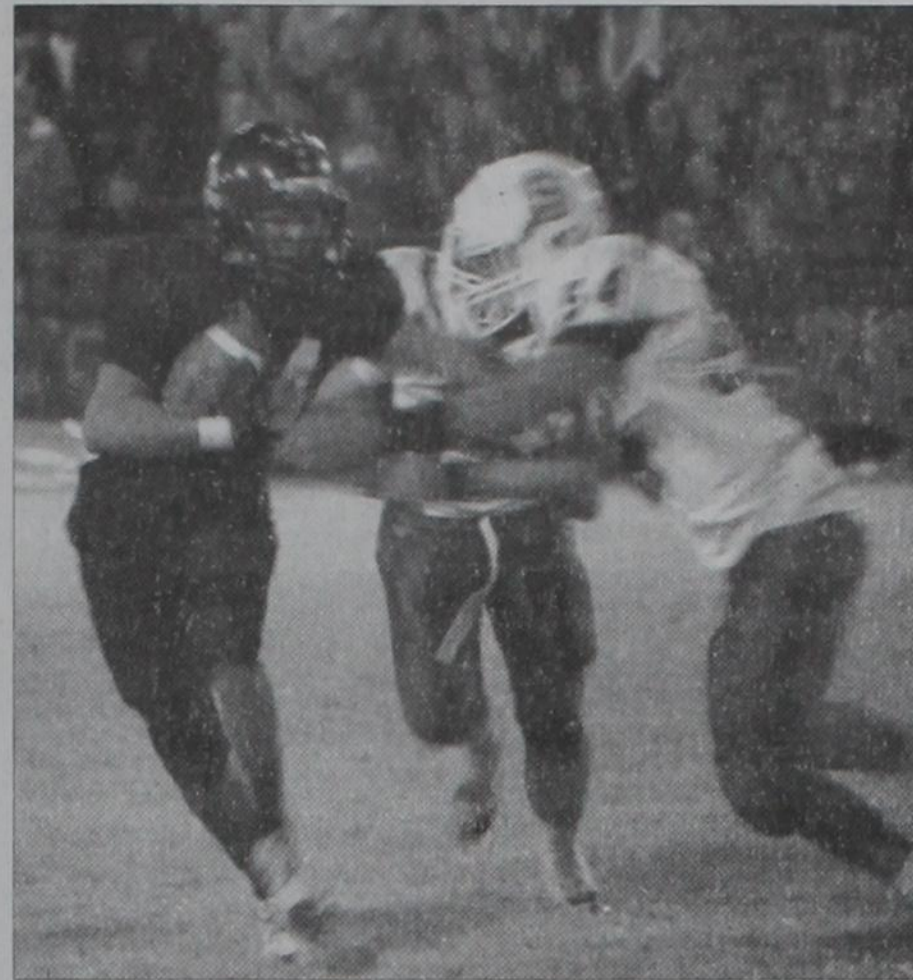
Good to see Bernice Hefley at the party; she looks real good.

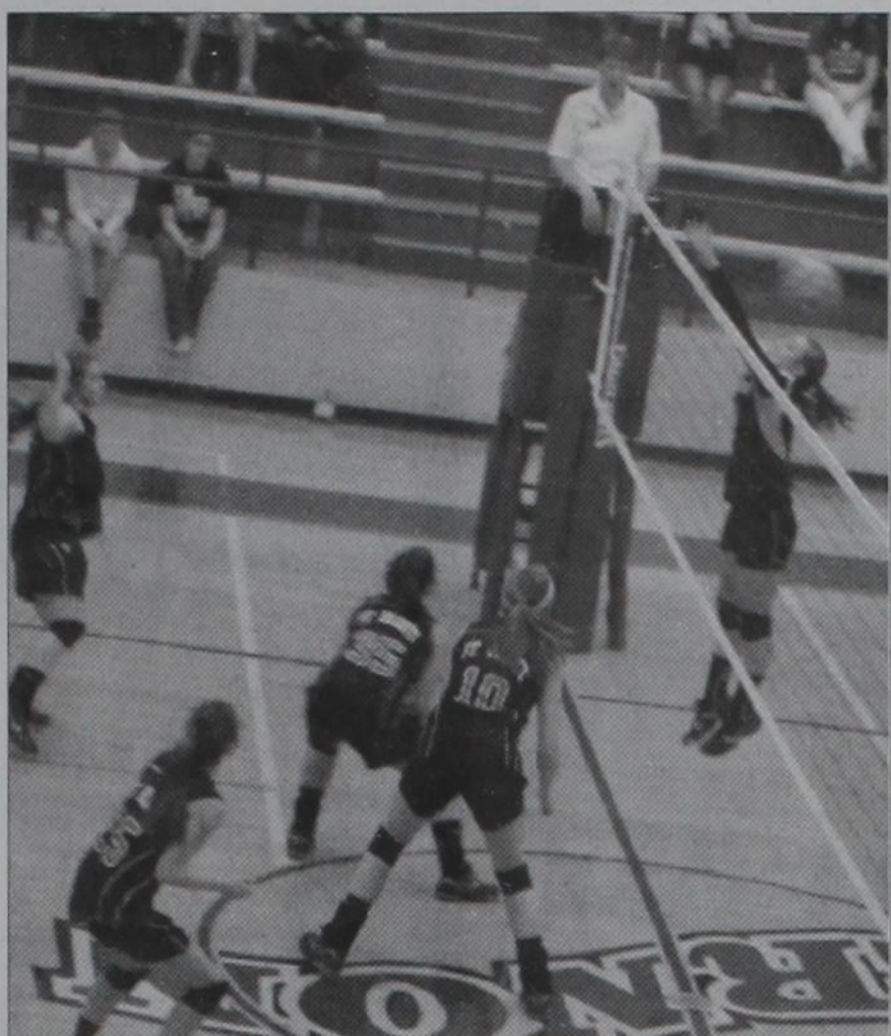

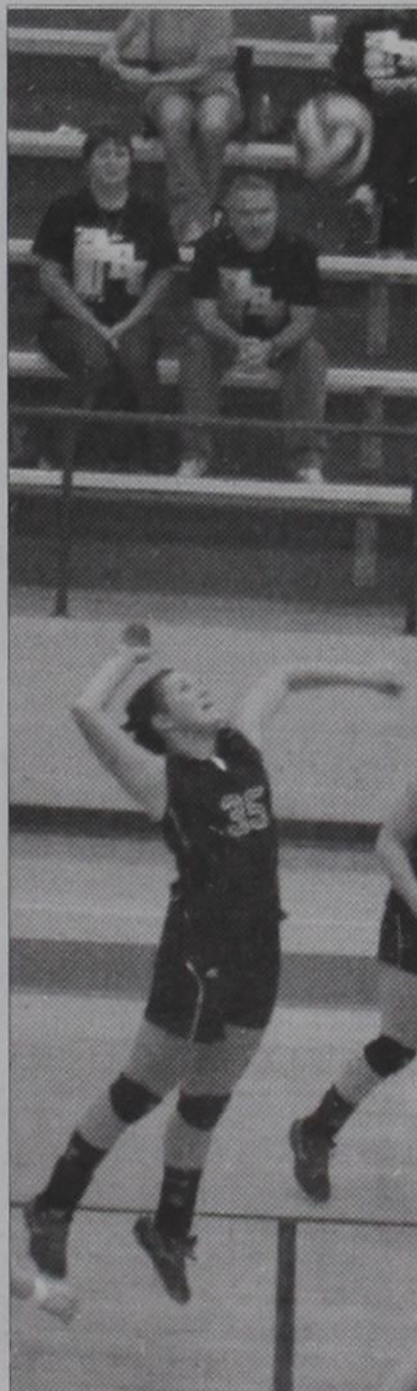
