## PROPOSITION NO. 1 ON THE BALLOT

Joint Resolution 42 proposes a constitutional amendment that would authorize the newly created county education districts to hold elections to exempt from ad valorem taxation a percentage married adult. The percentage exempted could not exceed $20 \%$ of such market value, and the amount exempted could not be less than $\$ 5,000$. The tricts to hold elections to exempt from ad valorem taxation not less than $\$ 3,000$ of the market value of the residence homestead of a disabled person or a person sixty-five years of age or older. Finally, the amendment would authorize elections in county education districts for the taxation of certain tangible per
ad valorem taxation by the legislature.
The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:
"The constitutional amendment to allow the voters of a county education district to adopt certain exemptions from
the district's ad valorem taxation for residence homesteads and to provide for the taxation of certain tangible personal
