

"Sweetwater Story" Exhibit Opens June 20

The Old Mobeetie Texas Association will host an open house for it new exhibit on June 20, 1998 fro 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The exhibit entitled "Sweetwater Story: the History of Wheeler County" is broad in scope, focusing on the land, prehistoric and historic Native Americans, buffalo hunters, Red River War, Fort Elliott, and Hidetown, later known as

The collection, begun by Sallie Harris in 1966, is showcased in the exhibit design. The Association has found that local history and Panhandle history, to a large extent, is not found in Texas public school textbooks. This fact has been the impetus for the Association pursuing grants that will provide money to build exhibits that interpret the artifacts in a way that support the classroom teacher who strives to teach local history.

The Sweetwater Story Exhibit will demonstrate the importance of Wheeler County as well as adjoining counties in the settlement of the Panhandle.

There will be several hands on opportunities for children to interact with exhibits.

A six foot by eight foot reproduction by Kenneth Wyatt of his original work, "Crossin the Sweetwater" will be featured on the title panel. This work depicts the 7th Cavalry expedition across the Panhandle in 1868 that was lead by Colonel George

Not only will the exhibit benefit the classroom teacher, but many adults who are now to the area or have not had the opportunity to visit the museum in recent years will enjoy the rich history of the area from the new interpretation of the valuable arti-

The open house is free of charge, but due to the expense of building such a comprehensive exhibit completely with volunteer labor for the most part, any contribution will be appreciation to defray the cost of



Wheeler and Hall Counties To Receive Road Work

Ballou Construction Company of Salina, Kansas announced their schedule for completing micro-surfacing project in Wheeler and Hall counties in a pre-construction conference held on May 28 to discuss construction practices, schedules and traffic safety, according to Roy Wright, Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) area engineer in Wellington who will oversee the construction. Wright said, "the contractor was selected through a competitive bidding process last February for the two projects which are designed to enhance pavement performance and increase safety".

The project in Wheeler County will be on US 83 from near the north city limits of Wheeler southerly through the city to near the North Fork of the Red River. The project in Wheeler will also include a small amount of work on SH 152 at the courthouse. The Wheeler county project will begin on June 12 and should be completed on June 29. During construction travel on US 83 will be restricted to one lane for short periods of time, the contractor has submitted plans for the use of a pilot vehicle to guide traffic through the work zone during working hours. After working hours, all lanes of traffic will be open each evening. According to Wright, microsurfacing is a unique mixture of aggregate, asphalt, water, cement and setting agents and is ready for traffic shortly after application. Wright expects an improved riding surface on US 83 with much better wet weather skid resistance and stopping ability for traffic.

The Hall County portion of the project will be on the outside travel lane of the north bound lanes of US 287 just south of the city of Memphis. The Hall county project is 6.2 miles in length and is designed to address the rutting observed in that area. Traffic control on this section of US 287 will consist of merely a lane reduction to one north bound lane of

travel for daylight hours. Wright expects minimal interference with travel on US 287. The Hall county project will begin on June 29 and should be completed by July 8. Ballou Construction Company does not expect to work on the busy 4th of July week-

The cost of the two projects is \$515,831.94, which was 14.79% under TxDOT's estimate. There were four bidders on these projects.

831 Miles Of Tex. Roads Planned To Be Widened

Eight hundred thirty-one miles of rural highway in Texas will be widened to four lane divided as part of a plan approved today by the Texas Transportation Commission.

The highways to be widened are included in 11 corridors that were selected by transportation commissioners at their monthly meeting in

The corridors are part of the Texas Trunk System, which was first approved by commissioners in 1990. The 10,500-mile trunk system is a planned four-lane, divided highway system that includes and complements the Interstate highway sys-

About 3,900 miles of the trunk system still needs to be expanded from two lanes to four lanes. The state plans to spend \$130 million a year upgrading roads on the trunk system. It will take about 8 to 10 years to complete improvements to the 831 miles approved today as Priority One corridors by the transportation commission.

From The Minister's Desk: Abraham Lincoln, the sixteenth

President of the United States, was assassinated at Ford's Theatre in Washington D. C. on April 14, 1865. After several stately ceremonies in a dozen cities, President Lincoln was buried in Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield, Illinois on May 4, 1885.

But since his burial, the body of President Lincoln has been moved sixteen times. Twice his coffin was opened--in April of 1887 and in September of 1901-- and his body viewed by witnesses who had personally known the President. Finally the coffin was permanently buried in steel and concrete beneath the floor of the Lincoln Memorial in Springfield, Illinois where it rests today.

Why was it necessary for the body of the assassinated President to be moved sixteen times? And why was his coffin opened twice and viewed by witnesses who had known him ?

The explanation is relatively simple. Persistent rumors had convinced many Americans that the President's body was not in his coffin. For this reason, the coffin was opened so these rumors could be permanently laid to rest --- along with the President's body.

Think of the pain and unhappiness that these rumors caused the family of President Lincoln.

But this is always the result of rumors. Lacking authoritative facts, information is loosely disseminated, causing pain, harm, and sorrow. These rumors and their destructive results are usually insinuated by people who preface their remarks with "they say" or "I

One of the great principles of Rotary International and Christianity is contained in a question. This question is: "Is it true?" The Apostle Paul wrote: "-- Laying aside falsehood, speak truth, each one of you, with his neighbor, for we are members of one another. "(Ephesians 4:25) Christians should always be truthful in the words that they speak or repeat.

Satan never ceases in his efforts to ensnare people and one of his best weapons is to weaken their relationship with other people through careless rumors. His diabolical purpose is served when people repeat without verification some "facts" about people.

If rumors can be responsible for disturbing the body of an assassinated President, they can also be responsible for destroying relationships between people.
