"Sweetwater Story" Exhibit Opens June 20

The Old Mobeetie Texas Association will host an open house for its new exhibit on June 20, 1998 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The exhibit entitled "Sweetwater Story: the History of Wheeler County" is broad in scope, focusing on the land, prehistoric and historic Native Americans, buffalo hunters, Red River War, Fort Elliott, and Hidetown, later known as

Mobeetie. The collection, begun by Sallie Harris in 1966, is showcased in the exhibit design. The Association has found that local history and Panhandle history, to a large extent, is not found in Texas public school textbooks. This fact has been the impetus for the Association pursuing grants that will provide money to build exhibits that interpret the artifacts in a way that support the classroom teacher who strives to teach local history.

The Sweetwater Story Exhibit will demonstrate the importance of Wheeler County as well as adjoining counties in the settlement of the Panhandle.

There will be several hands on opportunities for children to interact with exhibits.

A six foot by eight foot reproduction by Kenneth Wyatt of his original work, "Crossin the Sweetwater" will be featured on the title panel. This work depicts the 7th Cavalry expedition across the Panhandle in 1868 that was led by Colonel George Custer.

Not only will the exhibit benefit the classroom teacher, but many adults who are now to the area or have not had the opportunity to visit the museum in recent years will enjoy the rich history of the area from the new interpretation of the valuable artifacts.

The open house is free of charge, but due to the expense of building such a comprehensive exhibit completely with volunteer labor for the most part, any contribution will be appreciated to defray the cost of materials.

Former Bank President Pleads Guilty To Fraud

Rodney Bert Bass, former president of Wheeler Banking Center, pleaded guilty to bank fraud Monday, June 8.

Some 40 fraudulent loans from 1995 to October, 1997 were discovered by bank officials. The loans used some 20 fictitious customers and three actual bank customers and amounted to some \$459,000.

Some \$395,000 was reported to have been used for gambling on sporting events, dating back to 1995.

A date for sentencing has not been set. Bass could face a fine of \$1,000,000 and a sentence of up to 30 years.

Kidnappers Arrested In Las Vegas

The couple who kidnapped a car salesman in Amarillo and left him tied to a tree in Wheeler County has been arrested in Las Vegas. Jimmie Hays and Shannon Ludington were arrested Friday night. The couple was still driving the Jeep Eagle stolen from Amarillo.

Hays and Ludington took a 1998 Jeep Eagle for a test drive on April 1 of this year. Salesman Gil Reeves accompanied them on the drive. Reeves soon learned he was on more than a test drive.

The drive ended 6 miles north and 2 west of Wheeler on County Road G. Reeves was left tied and bound with tape. He had worked the tape off and was able to call for help when Bill Raines appeared at the location to work on a windmill that had been

damaged by a tornado in 1995.

The Wheeler County Sheriff's Department had also been notified by the fugitives where Reeves could be found.

Ludington and Hays were featured on "America's Most Wanted" the latter part of April. Numerous leads were checked, but the couple escaped capture until Friday, June 12.

The couple was stopped in Las Vegas because of an expired tag on the Jeep Eagle. They remained in Las Vegas at last report.

Lubbock will have first chance to try Hays and Ludington on assault charges. Amarillo, Potter County, will have a chance to try them on kidnapping and aggravated robbery. The couple may not be brought back to Wheeler County.

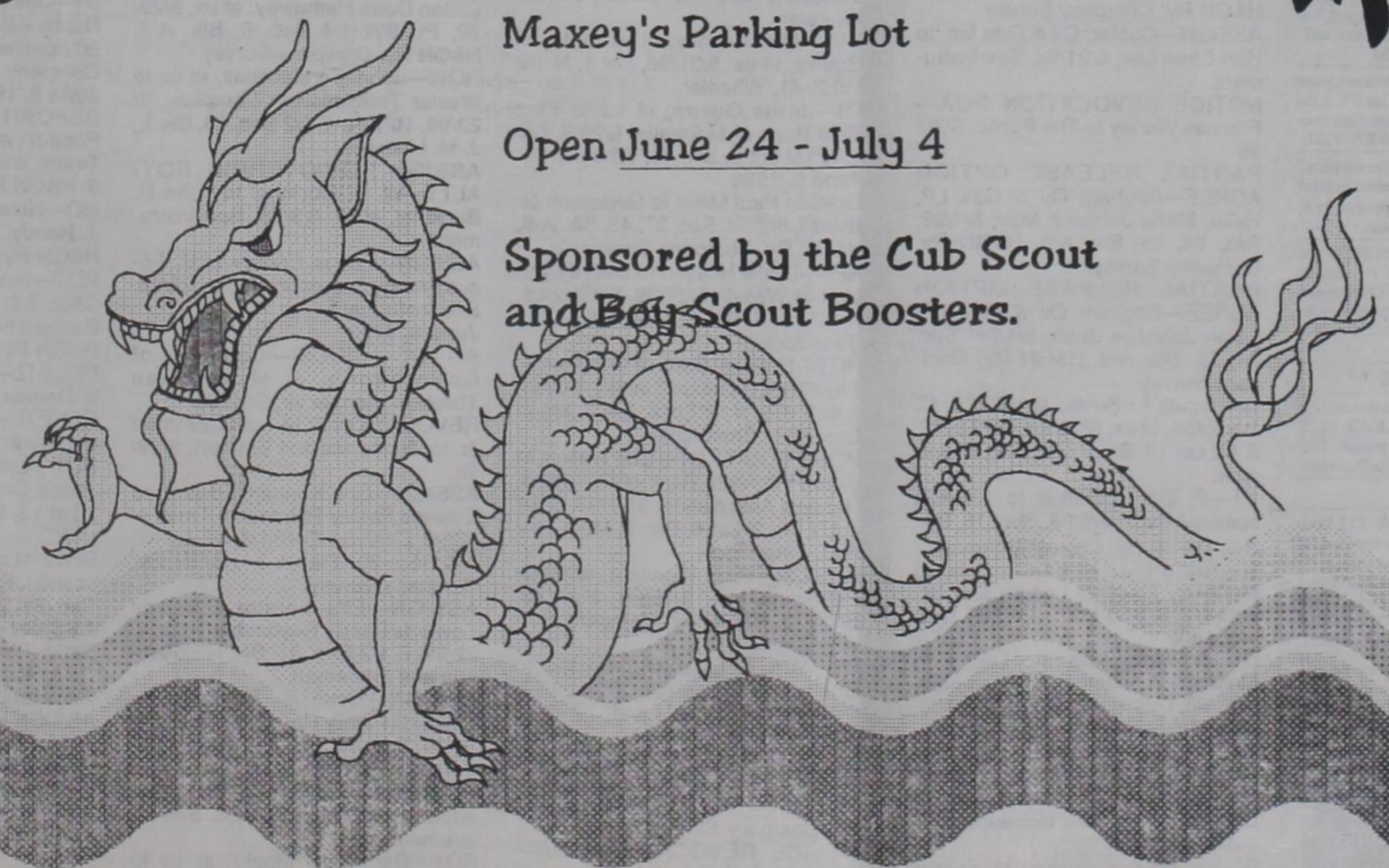

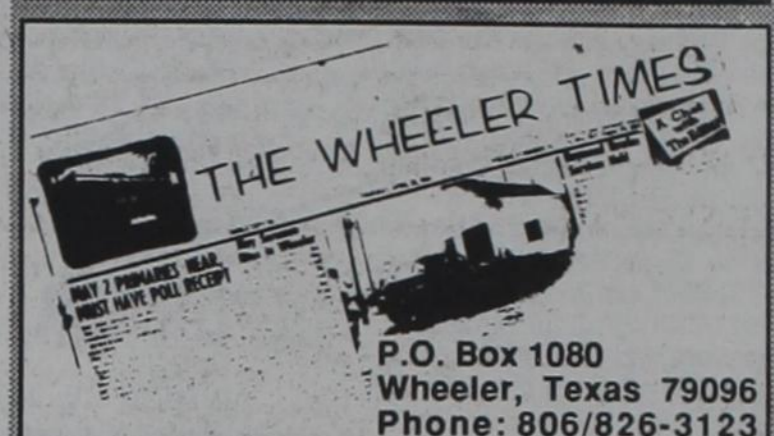

13, was cut out of the Mobeetie District and organized in 1907 with W. H. Roberts and F. M. Totty as trustees. A one-room schoolhouse was built in the Totty pasture that year on section 71, Block A-5 on a little ridge about a mile north of the present location. People in the community decided that Mountain View was a good name since such a good view could be commanded from the ridge on which it was located, but all along and to this day the building was and is called and better known as the Totty Schoolhouse. Some of the other very early trustees were Shirley Parks and Mack Jones.

A Mr. Cox is thought to have been the first teacher at the new school. Miss Elva Jones taught there in 1909 or 1910. C. M. Scott was also another early-day teacher. He was supposed to have been very good in math, and that was important in those days. In 1912-1913 Mountain View had a four-month school taught by Miss Sarah Witt of Wheeler. She had 31 pupils and was paid \$60.00 per month. In 1914 and 1915 Miss Roxie Scott taught with a whole roomful of pupils ranging from the primer into the high school grades.

The next year the building was moved to the O. C. Walker corner, its present location. Miss Inis Whiteside from Honeygrove, Texas, was the teacher for 1915-1916 term at the new location. She had 41 pupils that year. Some of the many teachers who taught at the present location were Miss Ruth Jones, Miss Alma Nichols, a Mrs. Robison, Mrs. Elmer Luttrell, Marie Waters Leslie, Ann Totty Hull, Mr. and Mrs. Bill Melton,

Some of the early teachers boarded "round", that is they stayed with one family for a few weeks and then stayed with some other family for a while. No one will forget there was no central heat then, so teachers and pupils studied at the kitchen or dining room table. There was no natural gas in that area until much later. Coal was hauled with a wagon and a team from Miami, and the school had a big potbellied stove that kept the room reasonably comfortable. Of course, there were no hot lunches. Everyone brought his own lunch--most of the time the whole family used a lard or a syrup bucket for that purpose. Biscuits and ham or sausage, and sometimes peanut butter, and sometimes an apple made a good lunch.

Of course, there were no buses then, so big and little pupils walked or rode horseback. A few books and a five-cent tablet took care of the necessities. A blackboard and chalk, a chart in the corner, and sometimes a world globe were additional helps, and cedar pencils sold for one cent.

A year or two after the school was moved to its present location, one Sunday afternoon it caught fire and burned to the ground. Community families donated money and work to rebuild. The men bought lumber and hauled it with wagons and teams, measured and hand-sawed every piece of lumber that went into the present building--no electricity in the community either.

At recess the group played town ball, blackman blue, darebase, anti-over or some other game where almost everyone enjoyed playing. The small children liked to play "Drop the Handkerchief", "Hide and Seek", "London Bridge is Falling Down", "Stealing Sticks", "Ring-a-round the Rosie", "Tag" and various other games.

Often on Friday afternoons students vied in spelling matches and cipher matches. On some Friday afternoons the group was entertained with a program put on by the Literary Society. Speeches were given, songs were sung, and dialogues were presented. There was variety and pupils did learn! No question schools were different then, but so was everything else. (Compiled by Alma Totty Seitz 1980) This was used at the first reunion. Those present that attended school at Totty were Hugh Bailey, Bill Bailey, Estelle Seitz Hodges, Jack Lewis, and Faye Thomas Smith.
