## Help in the great fight to combat Tuberculosis

As Christmas approaches each of us would like to feel that we have done something to add to another's happiness at this season.

The joy that Christmas normally brings is not complete unless we have that inner satisfaction that comes with know. ing we have made a contribution to the welfare of others, that we have overlooked no little thing that might make this Christmas a better Christmas.

Each person may know of some special thing he can do to make Christmas happier for another. For one person, it may be buying a doll for a neglected child. For another, it may be sending a basket of fruit to an invalid. But, regardlless of what we may do for individuals, there is one thing all of us can do for everyone in the community, including ourselves.

We can all buy and use Christmas Seals.
Christmas Seals have become an American tradition. They have become a tradition because they are a symbol of an important piece of work that has been carried on in this country for forty-odd years, and by the Wheeler County Tuberculosis Association for four years.

That work is the nationwide campaign against tuberculosis inaugurated in 1904 by the National Tuberculosis Association and continued without interruption by the Associa-
tion and its increasing number of affiliates in every state. One of these affiliates is the Wheeler County Tuberculosis Association which, in close cooperation with the health department, is waging an effective battle to eradicate tuberculosis in our community.

In its campaign against tuberculosis, which kills nearly 50,000 Americans a year, or at the rate of one person every 10 minutes, our Association is engaged in giving skin tests, taking $X$-rays and helping persons who have shown symptoms of TB.

The association depends entirely upon the annual sale of Christmas Seals to finance its projects. Those of us who buy and use Christmas Seals will have the satisfaction of knowing, when Christmas Day dawns, that we have made a contribution to the welfare of the community in which we live.

Eighty per cent of the money you spend for Christmas Seals stays right here at home, in Wheeler County, to help minister to your own friends and neighbors.

The Wheeler County Tuberculosis Association is mailing seals this week and asks that you please return the money for them as quickly as you receive them. If you fail to receive your seals, please notify the treasurer, G. W. Hefley, or the executive secretary, Mrs. J. C. Howell, at Wheeler and you will be supplied immediately.
