## Then and Now

During the early thirties, when nafural gas was selling for the same price in Wheeler it is now selling for, the following wages were being paid in Wheeler:

Carpenters, 1st Class, 50c Hr. Carpenters, 2d Class, 30c
Carpenters, 3d Class, 20c

GN HANDS, 12 to 14 hours per day, $\mathbf{\$ 3 . 0 0}$ per day, no Overtime.

FILLING STATION EMPLOYEES, 12 to 14 hours, $\mathbf{\$ 5 0 . 0 0}$ to $\$ 60.00$ per month.

SCHOOL TEACHERS, $\mathbf{\$ 7 5 . 0 0}$ to $\mathbf{\$ 1 2 5 . 0 0}$ per month, warrants sold at discount.

CLERKS IN STORES, 10 to $\mathbf{1 2}$ hours, $\mathbf{\$ 5 5 . 0 0}$ to $\mathbf{\$ 7 5 . 0 0}$ per month.

THEN, the local gas company operated only one gas well, with sufficient pressure to bring gas to Wheeler and the towns north.

NOW, the gas company is having to tie onto a third well, and operate 1 to four compressors, depending on temperatures, to supply its eustomers.

Can any thinking person say the gas company is not entitled to a SUBSTANTIAL rate increase at this time.
