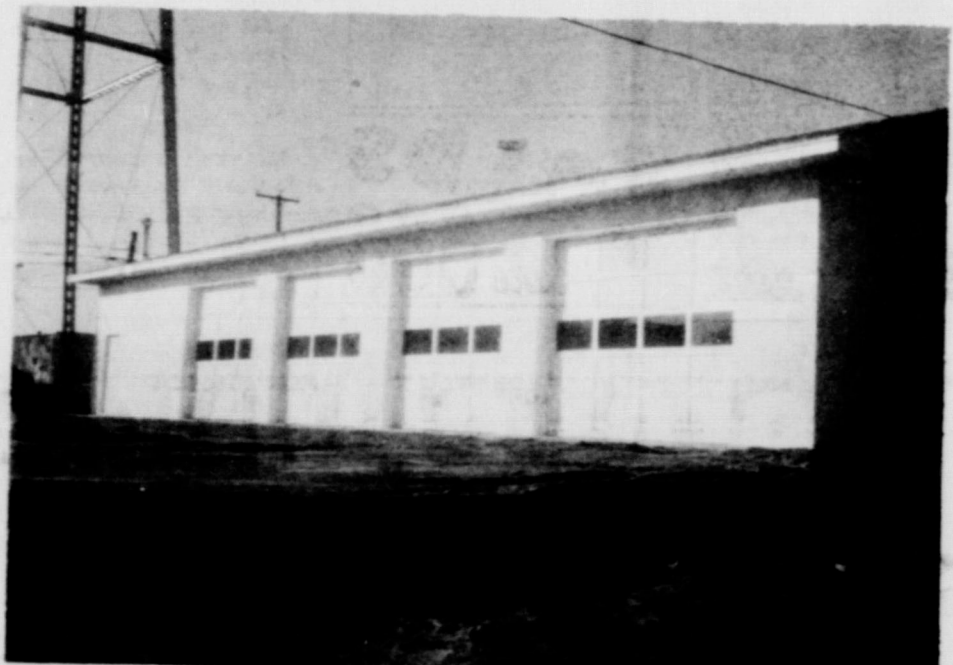

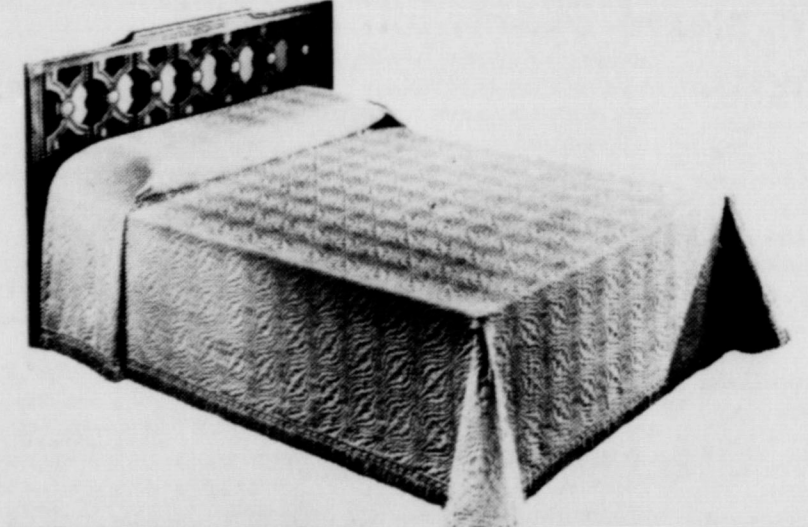

basting and it will remove easily leaving little or no mark on the fabric.

Also a "polyspun" thread has been developed by a company. It is designed to sew kits, stretch, bonded, synthetic and permanent press fabrics where elasticity, endurance and smooth seams are important. It can be pressed at all iron settings but requires special adjustments for the sewing machine. Use a 10-12 stitch per inch length and loose, balanced tension.

Fondue dishes have become the latest in refreshments for parties and informal entertaining. A fondue dish is where a person dunks bite-

size food in a hot liquid or mixture for enhancement of flavor. Fondue sets - a pan atop with its own source of heat that cooks right at the table - are designed primarily for the three basic types of fondue. Most familiar is the cheese kind, essentially Swiss cheese melted with white wine in a heavy earthenware or enamel dish served with a crusty French bread speared on a long-handled, sharp-tined fork. In meat fondue, the beef is dipped in any of several piquant sauces. Dessert fondue features sweet chocolate melted with fruits, cookies, marshmallows and cake served as the dipping morsels.

Cold-water detergents have their consumer acceptance test. Tests have shown that the fear of bacterial infection from cold water washing is unfounded. Researchers agree tumble drying at Standard 160 F. kills as much or more bacteria than the hot-cycle washer does. To improve cleaning of heavily soiled items, Extension home management specialists recommend using the cold water detergents in hot water. They even work better at high temperatures.

A new pure silk thread has been introduced for home sewing, and you can buy it in 90 colors. Use silk thread for sewing wool, silk or a blend of the two. The thread is elastic, strong and soft and has a sheen. Use it for

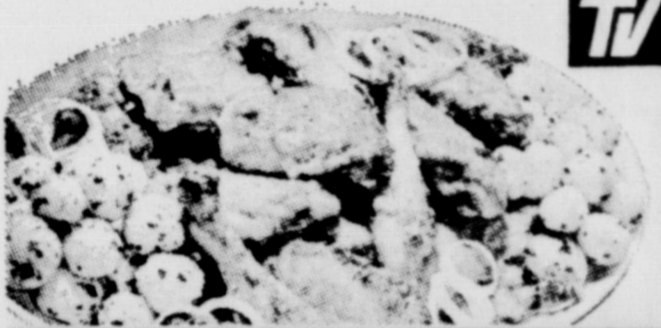
