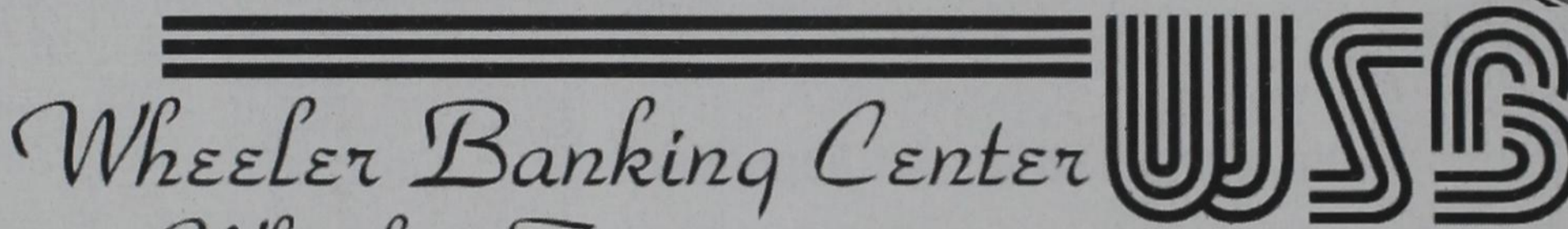
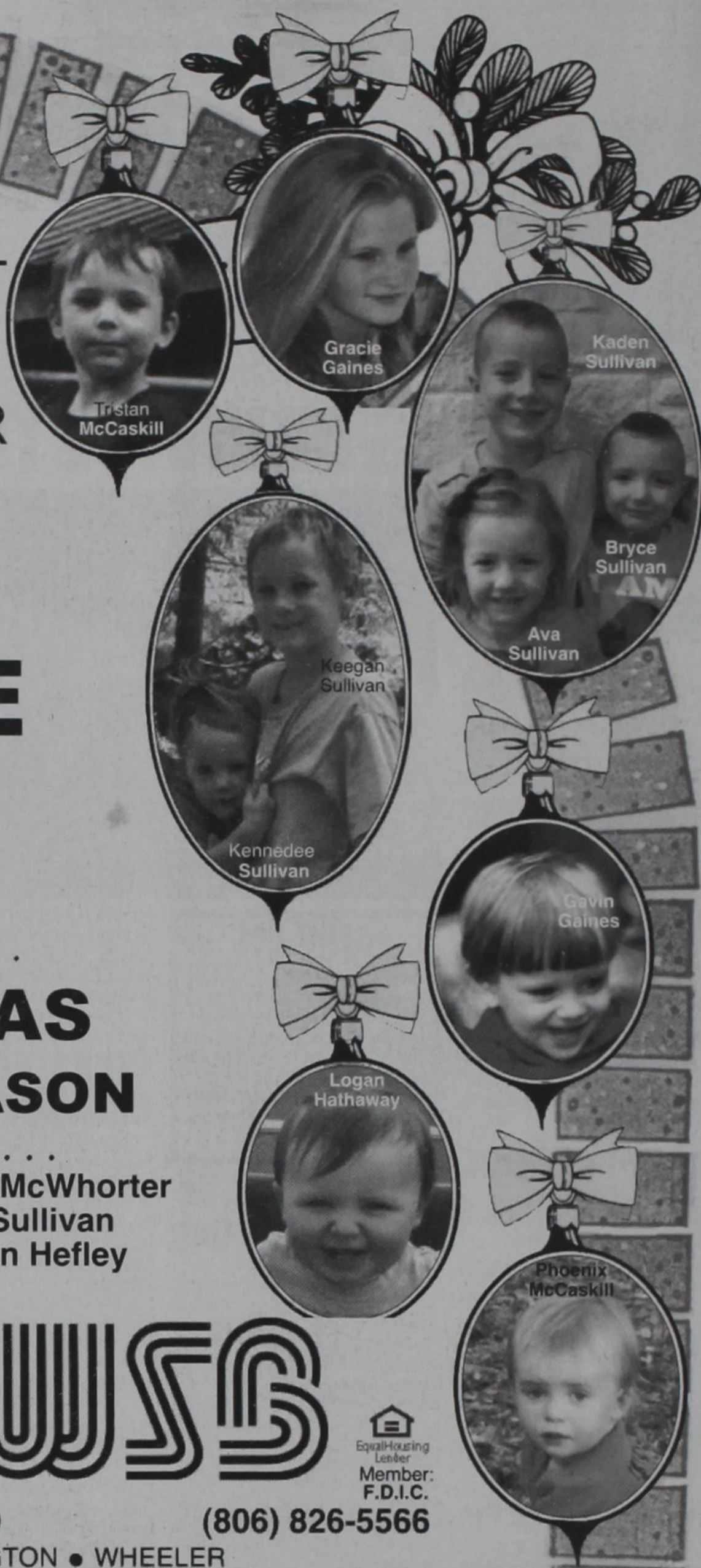

### What To Do With All My Leaves

Our yards are going dormant and the turfgrasses are setting idle with the recent winter weather conditions. Fescue will remain green and gather sunlight during the moderate temperatures, however, many yards are covered with a layer of Mulberry, Sycamore, or Pecan leaves. These leaves should be mulched on to the yard or removed. Leaves left on the lawn for an extended period of time can actually weaken the turf due to the grass's inability to gather sunlight. As mentioned, a mulching mower will do wonders, just mow over the leaves and they will add organic matter back to your soil which will breakdown over time and serve as a fertilizer. If removing the leaves from the lawn, do not send them to the local landfill. Lawn clippings, leaves and food residue constitute approximately 23% of the nation's solid waste. Use the materials for compost. Leaves can be bagged from the lawn and applied across your garden. Grinding the leaves with a mulching mower with a bagger attachment works great. The leaves can then spread throughout the garden and roto-tilled into the soil. Apply thin layers of leaves at a time, it will make tilling easier. Thick layers of leaves will cause difficulty tilling and the

leaves will not mix into the soil uniformly. Remember think layer...then till. You may have to do the process several times. By spring, your garden will be well on its way to providing nutrients to your crops from the decomposing leaves. A light application of nitrogen fertilizer (1 cup per 5-square feet) will speed up the decomposition process. Remember...Do Not Bag It!...leaves and grass clippings are great compost. This way you can enrich your soil and save space in our area landfills.

## "KID'S, ATE LAST"

Since Thanksgiving Day, is almost here again, I started thinking about what some of them were like, when I was a kid. The best I can remember, most of the time, we ate dinner at Uncle Fat and Aunt Vera's house. That made sense, because they had a larger house, with water piped into the kitchen. They had a good size table in their dining room, which was adequate for the seven in their family. When all our kinfolks got together, the number could rise to more than twenty. With a crowd like that, we couldn't all eat at once. The grown-ups, usually ate first, which is logical, when you think about it from the parents' viewpoint. All the kids were outside playing anyway, so just let them keep on doing that. There was room at the table for the adults to sit down, eat, talk and enjoy themselves. After they were

We'd usually have two freezers going at the same time, and were never short of volunteers to help. 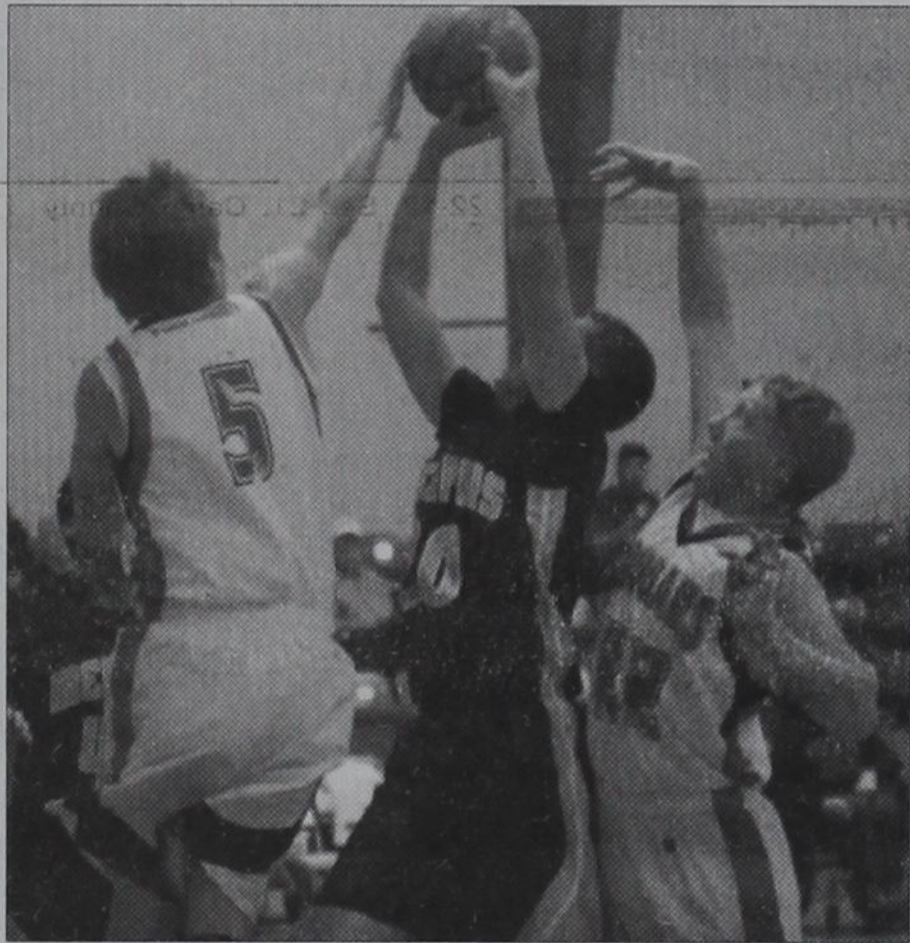

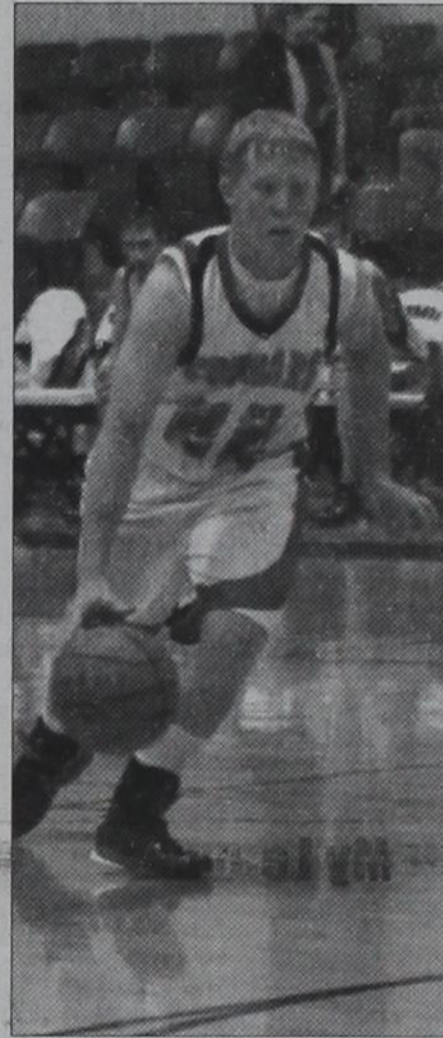
