because broiler-fryers are in  
plentiful supply this month.

In days gone by, women had  
to draw their own chickens,  
spend hours—very unpleas-  
ant ones—picking pinfeath-  
ers from the birds and then  
more hours wrestling huge  
cast iron skillets full of  
splattering chicken. The  
result was, of course, well  
worth it; but today's woman,  
after choosing a plump USDA  
inspected fowl—already cut  
in serving pieces—even gets  
away from the fat-splattering  
mess of pan-frying chicken  
by using quick shake mixes  
to coat the poultry and let-  
ting the oven do the rest.

1 C. Crushed herb-seasoned

1/2 C. butter or margarine,  
melted  
Combine crushed stuffing,  
cheese and parsley in a  
shallow pan. Dip chicken  
pieces in melted butter or  
margarine; then roll in stuff-  
ing mixture. Arrange, skin  
side up, on a large, shallow  
baking pan—don't crowd.  
Sprinkle with remaining  
butter and crumbs. Bake at

375 degrees for 45 minutes  
or until tender. Turning is  
unnecessary. Serves four.

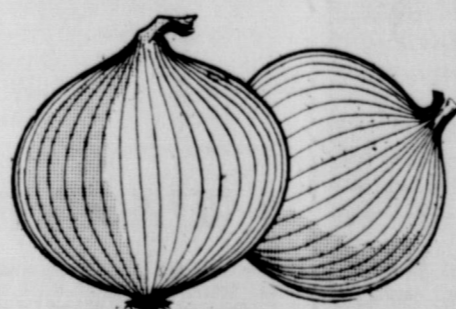

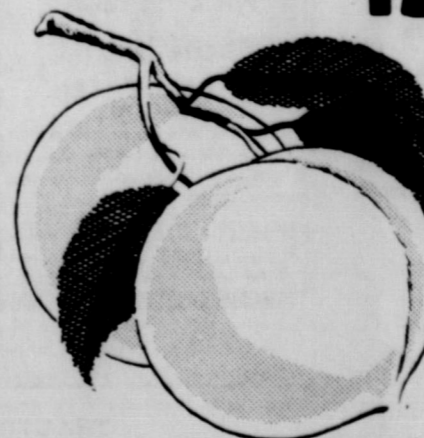

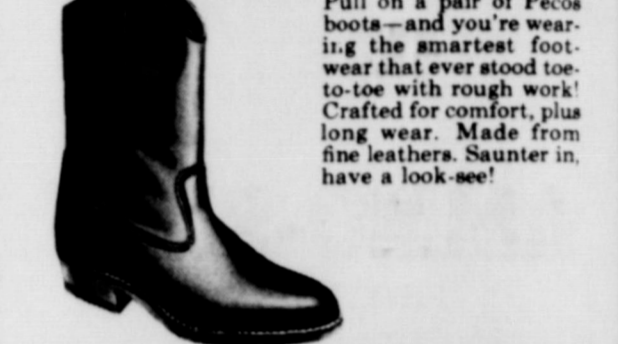
