
THREE MUSTANGETTES NAMED TO ALL-DISTRICT BASKETBALL TEAM

The Wheeler High School girls basketball team, which won this years District Championship, received another honor in a recent district coaches meeting. The other coaches of our district voted Beth Brown, Elise Christner and Missy Wiggins to the All District Team. they also placed Lynette Gaines, Mona Jennings and Tanya Rarden on the honorable mention squad.

Beth Brown lead the Mustangettes in field goad percentages with 48 and free throw percentage with 74%. She was also tied with Missy Wiggins for the most defension rebounds with 33. Beth's scoring average was 10.5 points per game.

Elise Christner averaged 9.0 points per game. She shot 43% from the field and 66% from the foul line. She was tied with Missy Wiggins for the most starts with 25.

Missy Wiggins lead the Mustangettes in scoring with an average of 16 points per game. She shot 39% from the floor and 62% from the foul line. Missy was tied with Beth Brown for the most defensive rebounds with 33 and she was tied with Elize Christner for the most starts with
